Update

The project to refurbish the library is progressing and staff have been working hard behind the scenes in preparation for the works.

We are intending to have no break in service whilst we move into temporary locations, however this will mean offering a reduced service from the current library while we move the stock to the different temporary locations.

The coffee shop will close on the 28th November, and the first floor reference library will also close at this time.

From the 1st December we will be offering a condensed service from the foyer area of Bury St Edmunds Library only.

The Shire Hall site will open on Monday 14th December, offering a full range of services.

Temporary Locations

The locations for the library during the refurbishment works have now been confirmed and we will have three temporary locations available.

From Monday 14th December a full range of services will be available from Shire Hall, which is on Raingate Street. site will have the same opening hours as Bury Library currently and offer a range of activities including Sunday Crafts, TopTime and Bookstart.

From Monday the 4th January a mobile library will be available on Mondays and Fridays on the market square outside the Woolworths building.

A small service will also be available in the Friend's Meeting House from the 4th January. This site will be open 10:00 – 16:00 Monday – Saturday and will be stock a selection of fiction and talking books to borrow from. Customers will also be able to request their reservations to be delivered to this site for collection.

Shuttle Bus

Thank you to those customers who took part in the travel survey during August and September.

Based on the results we are going to be running a shuttle bus from the current library to Shire Hall on a Wednesday and Saturday each week. This will start in January and will be for a trial period initially. Timetable details will follow shortly.
