School Organisation Review

Group two schools: Beccles, Bungay, Leiston and Forest Heath

Suffolk County Council continues to work hard to raise standards of education across the county, through the school organisation review (SOR). This leaflet is designed to let you know what is happening in your area.

What is the story so far?

After extensive research during 2006, Suffolk County Council decided, in March 2007, to proceed to a second phase of the school organisation review. A set of principles were also agreed to guide the review (available at www.suffolk.gov.uk/sor).

The focus of the second phase is developing specific proposals for individual schools. All proposals will need to meet the principles agreed by the county council in March 2007.

Due to the number of schools potentially affected, the county council decided to carry out the review in three phases:

- Group one: Lowestoft and Haverhill
- Group two: Forest Heath (Mildenhall, Brandon and Newmarket) Beccles, Bungay and Leiston
- Group three: Bury St Edmunds, Sudbury, Stowmarket and Thurston.

What is happening in my area?

- Schools in group 2 (Beccles, Bungay, Leiston and Forest Heath areas) joined the review in the spring term 2008.
- During the spring term local stakeholder forums (LSF) were set up. These forums include parents, headteachers, teachers, union officials and councillors.
- During the summer term the LSF have been discussing possible options for public consultation in the autumn.

How and when will I be able to give my views?

The options will be published during September. From the date the options are published, you will have 12 weeks to give your views.

During September 2008, you should receive a copy of the consultation booklet for your area in the post. This will include a hard-copy questionnaire for you to complete and return.

An online questionnaire will also be available, if you prefer to give your views that way.

There will be a series of public meetings where you can ask any questions you may have about the options and give your views.

What happens once I have given my views?

Once consultation has ended all of the views will be analysed. This information will then go to the appropriate meeting of Suffolk County Council's Cabinet. Your views will help to inform the decisions taken by the Cabinet.

Depending on what the Cabinet decides, either public notices will be issued setting out the agreed changes or further options will need to be developed.

What is the timeline for the review in my area?

Autumn 2008:	consultation on options
Spring/Summer 2009:	undertake legal process for changes
September 2011:	Year 5 pupils stay in their primary school
September 2012:	Year 6 pupils stay in primary school Middle schools close, Year 7 and 8 pupils transfer to secondary schools

What does this mean for my child?

On the reverse of this leaflet there is a timeline where you can track your child's journey through school taking into consideration the review.
