

Unisafe Level Four –Physical de-escalation Annual Re-accreditation

Target Group - ACS Provider Services - Medium & High Risk Environments

This event is an annual one-day refresher event for the Unisafe Level Two & Three programmes (if required).

Pre-course Requisites:

Delegates need to have booked on or have attended Level one (Theory) & Level two (Physical de-escalation). Level two should have been attended within the past year.

Pre-Course Preparation:

“Health Declaration & Training Conditions” (will be sent with joining instructions), please complete and bring along on the first day of training.

Aims & Learning objectives:

Delegates will be asked to demonstrate an ongoing degree of competency around their knowledge and application of physical interventions. There is an opportunity to discuss the applications of the skills within practice over the previous twelve months and to address any arising issues. The delegates will be assessed to ensure a suitable degree of competency is reached.

By the end of the course, participants should be able to:

- Identify aspects of the law relating to physical interventions
- Have an understanding of the risk management process
- Identify your own responsibilities, policies and procedures and those of your employers
- Recognise signs of behaviour escalation
- Understand the implications of Manual Handling
- Understand the issues around Positional Asphyxia
- Demonstrate effective selection of the appropriate option to de-escalate a difficult situation
- Display a required degree of competence when using a physical intervention
