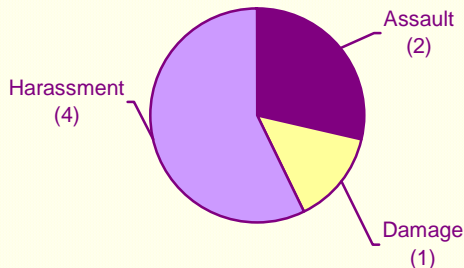
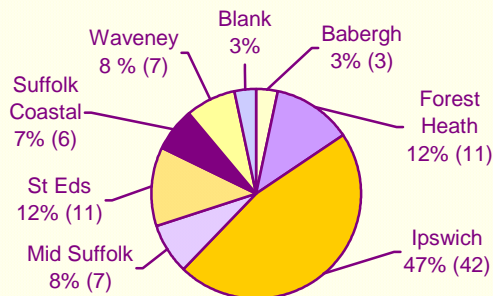


RACIAL HARASSMENT (7 incidents took place in Mid Suffolk during Q1 2007/08)

April 2007 - June 2007



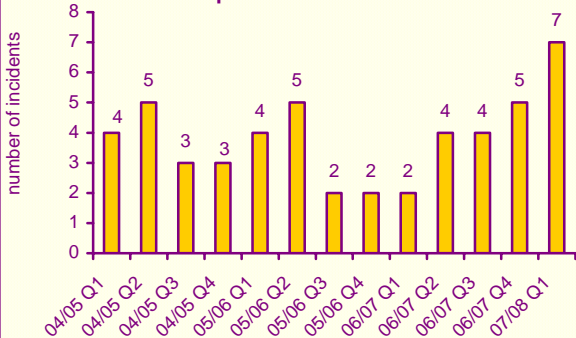
Percentage of racist incidents

*Non-Crime - These are hate incidents reported to the police that do not amount to a criminal offence. Source: Suffolk Constabulary

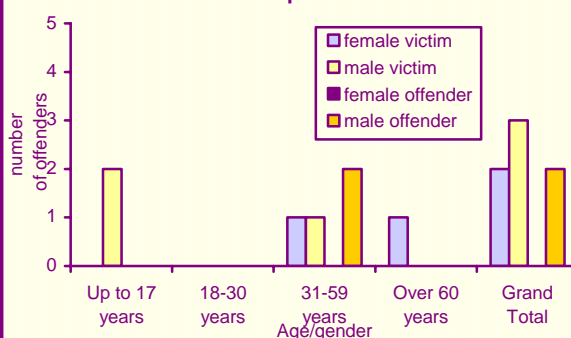

April 2004 - June 2007



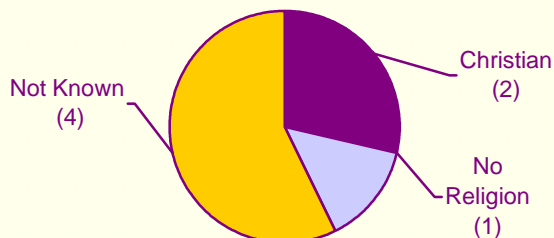

in Mid Suffolk April 2007 - June 2007

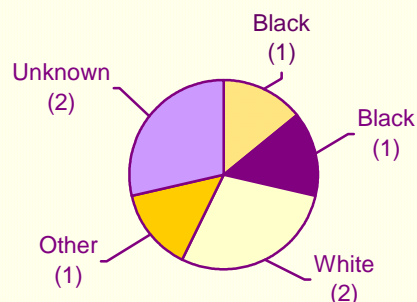


In addition, there were 2 victims of whom the age and gender were not known. There were also 5 offenders, which did not have recorded details of gender or age.

DOMESTIC VIOLENCE

- The proportion of domestic violence incidents where alcohol was a factor was 39.9%; this is down from 43.1% last quarter.
- 39.9% of incidents reported to the police involved repeat offenders or victims; this has also decreased from 41.8% for the end of year report 2006/07.
