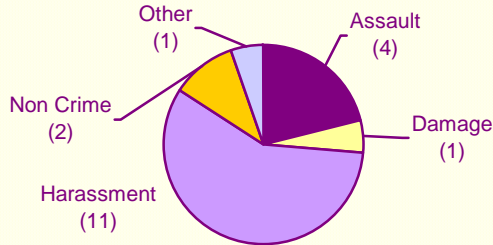
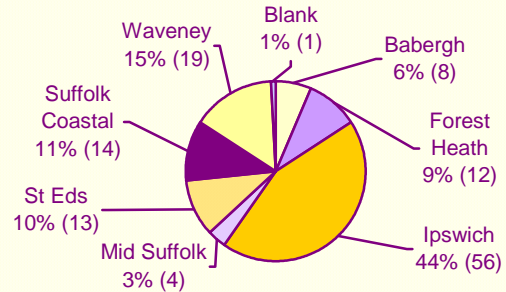


## RACIAL HARASSMENT (19 incidents took place in Waveney during Q3 2007/08)

October 2007 - December 2007**



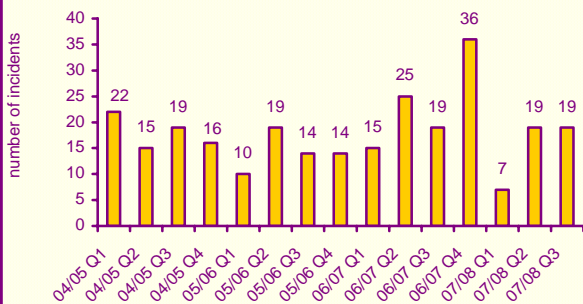
**Percentage of racist incidents

\* **Non-Crime** - These are hate incidents reported to the police that do not amount to a criminal offence. Source: Suffolk Constabulary

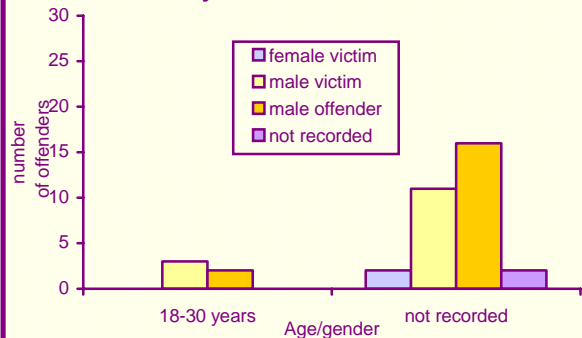

April 2004 - December 2007**



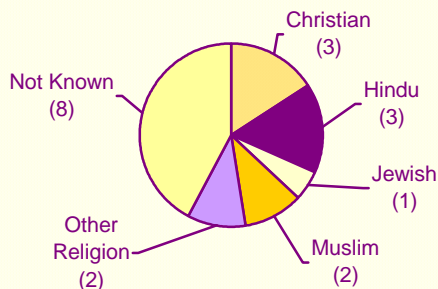

in Waveney October 2007 - December 2007**

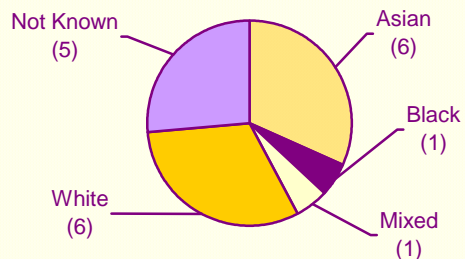


Out of 19 incidents only 16 of the males offenders age were not recorded.

## Recent Racial Harassment Initiatives

- Recorded 357 racist incidents across Suffolk during the first 9 months of 07/08 an increase compared to 327 for the first 9 months of 06/07.
- Worked with NHS hospitals and PCT's to promote the RHI service and 'common reporting form'.
- Extended the RHI Hate Crime counselling service, currently piloting a community support group.
- Produced literature in partnership with CYP to support children and parents in a school setting.
- Supported the "Glassboy" travelling puppet project across Suffolk schools.
- Launched a third party reporting centre at Beckrow Gypsy and Traveller site.
- Continued to work with partner agencies to deliver surgeries to support employees based at BT Martlesham to strengthen community cohesion.
- Standard discussions with mosques in Ipswich to encourage reporting of racial harassment.
