

Schoolsafe Generic Physical de-escalation programme

Staff needed to be booked on or have attended Module 1 (Legal Framework) & Module 2 (Theory of de-escalation) or equivalent. The school need to have completed Module 3 (Risk Management).

A risk assessment must be in place around the use of physical intervention prior to staff attending this module.
