

Revised admission arrangements for the school year 2011/12

Suffolk County Council hereby gives notice that it intends to admit up to 60 pupils (the admission number) to the Reception Year of Combs Ford Primary School, Stowmarket, in the school year 2011/12. This is instead of the 90 places that would normally be available at this school.

The reasons for setting a number that is lower than normal are that: there will be sufficient places available in the area to accommodate students of Reception age in 2011/12;

In 2009/10 62 pupils were admitted to the Reception class in the school. The expected number for 2010/11 is 61. It is expected that a similar number of pupils would be admitted to the Reception class of the school in 2011/12. Infant class size legislation means that children may not be taught in classes of more than 30 with one member of teaching staff. It would not be in the interests of efficient education to plan to admit to the school in 2011/12 a similar number of pupils as in the last two years.

Objections about the admission number by parents living in the area should be addressed, under regulation 20 of The School Admissions (Admission Arrangements) (England) Regulations 2008, to the Schools Adjudicator by 31 July 2010.
