Motion Text: Suffolk County Council, mindful of the particular impact of reducing services to children and young people and vulnerable young adults, and aware of the dangers to our core responsibilities from cuts to our staff, as an alternative to reducing the drawdown on reserves, will allocate the additional £7.189 million received in Social Care Grant and Rural Services Delivery Grant in the following amounts:
