

## Suffolk County Council meeting Thursday 9 July 2020, vote taken on Agenda Item 7, Motion 3

Motion 3 – Proposed by Councillor Jack Abbott and seconded by Councillor Sarah Adams.

Amended by Councillor Paul West seconded by Councillor Mary Evans.

This Council notes that, in 2016, it was reported by the Food Foundation there were more than 8 million people in the UK who had trouble putting enough food on the table, with nearly 5 million people thought to be regularly going an entire day without eating. In May 2020, an End Child Poverty report, based on Department for Work and Pension figures for 2018/19, showed that an estimated 50,000 children were living in poverty in Suffolk.

This Council notes that, during the Coronavirus pandemic, the Council has allocated £250,000 of funding to be made available to food banks, through Fare Share, to help local families put food on the table. However, the true long-term extent of the Coronavirus pandemic on jobs and livelihoods is not yet known, and it is likely to put additional pressure on the finances of local families. The Trussell Trust has already reported that food banks nationally saw an 89% increase in demand during April 2020, and the number of families with children receiving emergency food parcels almost doubled compared with last year.

The Council also recognises that the Government's commitment to the UN's 17 Sustainable Development Goals (Global Goals) which apply internationally and domestically, through Goal 2, and commits governments to ending hunger by 2030.

## Therefore, this Council:

- 1. Nominates a Cabinet Member with responsibility for delivering food justice in Suffolk;
- Will continue with existing measures, and introduce new ones, to increase the take up of free schools meals in all schools, and welcomes the government's announcement on providing vouchers to support pupils eligible for free school meals over the summer holiday;
- 3. Requests the Leader of Suffolk County Council to write to the relevant minister to ask the government to enshrine its existing commitment to UN Sustainable Development Goal 2 into domestic legislation;
- 4. Asks the Chair of the Scrutiny Committee to investigate the extent and causes of hunger in Suffolk and make recommendations about what can be done to tackle it, by adding the issue to a Scrutiny Committee agenda within six months:
- 5. Will work with our District and Borough Councils and other partner organisations, through the Poverty Strategy, to develop and implement a

- Food Justice Action Plan by the end of 2021 so that the issue of food poverty in Suffolk can be accurately quantified and subsequently eliminated;
- 6. Welcomes the £250,000 made available by the County Council to food banks in Suffolk; and
- 7. Welcomes the Department for Education funding of £963,000 to be provided to Suffolk this summer for the Holiday and Activity Programme.
