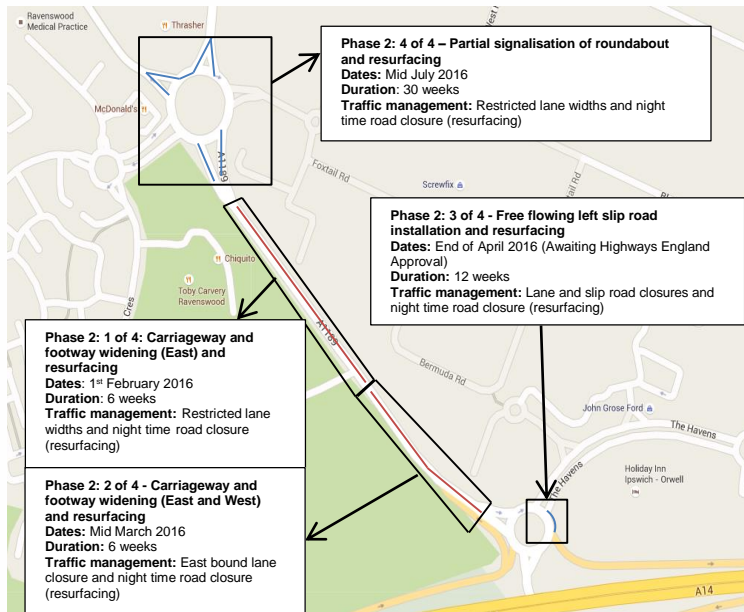


Phase 2 – A1189 Nacton Road Highway Capacity Improvements

A1189 Nacton Road – From the Thrasher roundabout to The Havens roundabout



Works information

Planned start date: Monday 25th January 2016
Completion: November 2016
Duration: 9 months
Working times: Monday to Friday 7am-5pm with possible Saturday working

This is the second phase of the improvement works along Ransomes Way and Nacton Road.

Phase 2 of the Highways capacity scheme includes:

- Minor vegetation works during week commencing 25th January 2016
- Carriageway and footway widening along the length of Nacton Road between both roundabouts to improve capacity.
- Installation of a free flowing left slip road at the Havens roundabout
- to the A14 approach. (Awaiting Highways England approval)
- Partial signalisation of the Thrasher roundabout
- Resurfacing of all sections

Information for residents and businesses

Traffic Management: For the duration of the works, there will be a number of traffic management arrangements. Restricted lane widths will be in place for the signalisation works and carriageway widening. Lane and slip road closures will be in place to install the free flowing left slip road. For all resurfacing works, night time road closures will be in place.

Traffic: Unfortunately the location and nature of these works will have an impact on traffic in this busy location. We will do our best to minimise disruption during this time, but please allow sufficient time for your journeys in this area throughout the duration of the works.

Buses: We apologise in advance if our works cause disruption to your bus service. Please check with the bus company for any alterations to the service – contact information can be found on the timetable leaflet for the service published on www.suffolkonboard.com

During and after the works

Details on future phases of the work are currently being finalised and include improvements around St Augustine's.
