


Ransomes Way/ Felixstowe Road/ Nacton Road, Ipswich Highway Capacity Improvements

Ransomes Way/ Central Avenue Roundabout

Felixstowe Road/ Ransomes Way (Sainsbury's) Roundabout, Ipswich



Works information

Planned start date: Friday 3 July 2015

Duration: July – November 2015

This is Phase 1 of a wider scheme and includes:

- Road widening at roundabouts to create additional lanes and improve capacity.
- Relocation of existing signalised crossing north of Central Avenue roundabout.
- New pedestrian islands and toucan crossing.
- Resurfacing and lining.

Future Phases:

- Improvements along Ransomes Way and Nacton Road to the junction with the A14.

Traffic Management

The majority of the works will be carried out using lane closures. The lane closures will be in place for the duration of work. However, some works will require temporary traffic lights to be used.

Resurfacing work will be undertaken at night with the roads closed. Signed diversion routes will be in operation.

Access for emergency service will be available at all times.

The date of these works may be subject to change due to factors beyond our control, such as periods of bad weather.

Who will be carrying out the works?

Suffolk Highways will be carrying out these works (a partnership between Suffolk County Council and Kier). We will do our best to minimise inconvenience and disruption during these works but unfortunately roadworks usually involve some delay to road users for which we apologise in advance.

During and after the works

This is the first in a number of phases of the improvement works along Ransomes Way and Nacton Road. Details on future phases of the work are currently being finalised and include improvements to the roundabouts at Ravenswood Avenue and The Havens.

Access to properties and businesses within the roadworks site will be available subject to ongoing operations. Staff on site will be able to answer any questions and help you safely get in or out of the roadworks site.

Traffic: Unfortunately the location and nature of these works will have an impact on traffic in this busy location. We will do our best to minimise disruption during this time, but please allow sufficient time for your journeys in this area throughout the duration of the works.

Buses: We apologise in advance if our works cause disruption to your bus service. Please check with the bus company for any alterations to the service – contact information can be found on the timetable leaflet for the service published on www.suffolkonboard.com

Other services have been notified of these works, including local bus operators, the District Council for bin collections.
