
Welcome to our spring term 2024 newsletter. Huge thanks for your incredible hard work in supporting our children in care during the autumn term and thank you for completing high quality and insightful ePEPs. We were very pleased to read about their achievements and progress, and the support that you have put in place to enable them to thrive and excel.

As you will be aware, we quality assure every single ePEP each term. For the autumn term the compliance was 96.5%, with 81.5% of all ePEPs rated at least effective (green).

We provide detailed feedback on all ePEPs which we would encourage you to read to both celebrate the strengths of the document and support any follow up actions for future ePEPs. To access the feedback, please go to the pupil's Document section on Welfare Call and click to open the Word version of the autumn term ePEP. It will open as a continuous document and the evaluation page will be near the end.


The Welfare Call ePEP now contains the Summary Page feature. This is automatically populated with information that is recorded in the ePEP during the term and can be used as a one-page profile to share with key stakeholders in the pupil's care plan, including the pupil themselves. You may wish to share this at their PEP meeting, CiC Review or, for those with an EHCP, at their Annual Review.

Key PEP reminders for the Spring Term 2024

- Please complete the teacher SDQ questionnaire for this academic year, if you
 have not already done so, and record the score on the Personal Development
 Tab. This score should be used to inform the personal development provision
 in place for a pupil.
- 2. Record any actions agreed at this term's PEP meeting (and/or other meetings such as an EHCP Annual Review) on the Planning and Pupil Voice Tab. You can also record decisions and actions made during conversations and email dialogue. Please just select the relevant meeting type from the drop-down menu:



3. If a pupil moves school mid-term, please ensure the ePEP is filled in with details of their provision, experience and targets to date, so that the receiving school have a really clear picture of their strengths and needs and can then update the ePEP for the remainder of the term.

- 4. Complete the Attainment and Progress Tracking tab each term, with progress in all subjects recorded (regardless of whether a formal data drop has taken place during the term). Please collect progress feedback from the pupil's teachers so that we have an accurate picture of their performance each term. For pupils with EHCPs, please also record their termly progress against their EHCP outcomes on this tab.
- 5. For children with SEND, please ensure that the SEND Tab has been updated and SEND documents such as Annual Reviews, uploaded into the Documents section.
- Please start populating the ePEP at the beginning of each term. The submission date for all ePEPs is set for two weeks before the end of each term which means that the spring term submission date is Friday 15 March 2024.
