# SUFFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL (PARISH OF MILDENHALL) MODIFICATION ORDER (No. 3) 2025

Public footpaths, bridleways, restricted byways and byways open to all traffic are recorded on definitive maps and statements. These maps and statements provide conclusive legal evidence of the existence of public rights. Suffolk County Council is responsible for the definitive map and statement and has a duty to amend them when <a href="evidence">evidence</a> suggests that they are inaccurate or incomplete. Such amendments are made by means of modification orders under section 53 of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981. These orders do not come into effect until confirmed, and if there are any objections the County Council must refer the order and objections to the Department of Environment, Food and Rural Affairs in Bristol.

The County Council has made a modification order under Section 53 to add a footpath as detailed in the order. This order simply recognises the public rights that the authority believes exist. The order does not create any new public rights.

The right of objection to an order is a statutory right, but it should be exercised in a reasonable manner. The costs involved in dealing with objections to orders are normally awarded against objectors only in cases of unreasonable behaviour. If there are no objections to the order, or if all objections are withdrawn, the County

Council will confirm the order, and the definitive map and statement will then be modified. If there are any objections which are not withdrawn, the County Council must refer the order and objections to the Department of Environment, Food and Rural Affairs, who will appoint an independent Inspector to consider the order and hear the objections, normally by holding a public inquiry. The Inspector may confirm the order, with or without modifications, or may decide that the order should not be confirmed.

This Order is made by Suffolk County Council under section 53(2)(c)(i) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the Act"), because it appears to that authority that the Definitive Map and Statement for the parish of Mildenhall in the District of West Suffolk require modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in section 53(3)(c)(i) namely, the discovery by the authority of evidence which shows that a right of way which is not shown in the map and statement subsists or is reasonably alleged to subsist over land in the area to which the map relates being a right of way such that the land over which the right subsists is a public path.

The authority has consulted with every local authority whose area includes the land to which the Order relates. The Suffolk County Council hereby order that:

- 1. For the purpose of this Order the relevant date is 1 August 2025.
- 2. The Definitive Map and Statement for the parish of Mildenhall in the District of West Suffolk shall be modified as described in Part 1 and Part 2 of the Schedule and shown on the map attached to the Order.
- 3. This Order shall take effect on the date it is confirmed and may be cited as the Suffolk County Council (Parish of Mildenhall) Modification Order (No.3) 2025.

#### **SCHEDULE**

#### Part 1: Modification of Definitive Map

Description of footpath to be added:

There shall be added to the Definitive Map for the parish of Mildenhall a footpath from a point at Ordnance Survey grid reference 56727,27705 (point A) to a point at Ordnance Survey grid reference 56760.27650 (point F) as shown on the attached map.

#### Part 2: Modification of Definitive Statement

Particulars of footpath to be added:

There shall be added to the Definitive Statement for Mildenhall the following particulars:

#### Mildenhall Footpath 65

Commencing at a junction with the U6018 road (Cow and Sheep Drove) at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OSGR) 56727,27705 (point A) and progressing in a southerly direction for approximately 80 metres to OSGR 56728,27697 (point B); changing to a south-easterly direction following the northern side of a wooden post and rail fence for approximately 47 metres to OSGR 56731,27694 (point C); changing to a southerly direction and continuing along the eastern side of the post and rail fence for approximately 96 metres to OSGR 56731,27685 (point D); leaving the fence and changing to a south-easterly direction for approximately 148 metres to OSGR 56742,27675 (point E); then running in a generally south-south-easterly direction for approximately 304 metres to a junction with the C603 road (Pollard's Lane) at OSGR 56760,27650 (point F).

Width: From a point at OSGR 56727,27705 to a point at OSGR 56731,27685: 1.22 metres

(The path width for this section is the metric equivalent of the width set out in the Mildenhall 1812 Inclosure award as 4 feet).

From a point at OSGR 56731,27685 to a point at OSGR 56760,27650: minimum of 1 metre

(The path width for this section is based on Schedule 12A of the Highways Act 1980, which sets out the minimum widths that the highway authority can enforce when seeking the reinstatement of a public right of way following surface disturbance of a cross-field route).
