

## Freedom of Information – Response –26656

Under the Freedom of Information Act 2000, I am writing to request the following information for each of the past three financial years (2023–24, 2024–25 and 2025-26 to date):

- 1. The number of applications submitted to discharge any of the following types of planning conditions attached to residential developments involving new-build dwellings:
- o Pre-commencement conditions
- o Pre-slab / pre-foundation conditions
- o Above-ground conditions (i.e., conditions that must be discharged before development can progress above ground floor level)
- 2. For each of the categories listed above, the number of discharge applications determined within the statutory 8-week period.
- 3. For each of the categories listed above, the average, minimum, and maximum determination times (in calendar days) for discharge-of-condition applications. We are writing to advise you that, following a search of our paper and electronic records, it has been established that the information you requested is not held by Suffolk County Council.
