

Freedom of Information – Response – 26657

- 1. I would like to know how much money the council paid in remedies to residents following complaints related to failures under the category of special educational needs and disabilities.
- I would like the information for the year 2025 to date January- December 1, compared with previous years 2024, 2023 and 2022.

We can confirm that Suffolk County Council holds this information. However, the information is readily accessible to you, as it is already in the public domain.

Section 21 of the FOIA states that a public authority does not need to provide information under section 1 of the Act if that information is reasonably accessible to the applicant by other means.

The information requested can be found in the Report taken to Audit Committee annually in September apart from the year to date but this will be available September 2026.
