

Environmental Information Regulations – Response - 26675

We are working with the River Waveney Trust to investigate the feasibility of installing fish passage structures downstream of two highways bridges near Harleston.

The project is aiming to install rock ramps on the riverbed on the downstream face of the bridges to reduce the drop in water level so that migratory fish and eels can traverse the structure. The engineering is unlikely to affect the engineering or structure of the Highways assets, but will directly abut the downstream face and we may have to engineer an interface. We would like to open communications and identify any constraints that might affect the feasibility of the works.

Please could we request:

- 1. Any available condition reports for the structures.
- 2. Any existing plans for works or maintenance to the bridges.
- 3. Details of any plans or ambitions to improve fish passage at these locations.
- 4. A local contact with whom we can discuss the works and any Highways permitting required.
