- 3. Please provide details of the total income to the council from the number of tickets issued of motorists paying traffic or parking violations fine in relation to this single street or car park in the 2024/25 financial year*
- 4. What was the total number of Penalty Charge Notices (PCNs) issued across the entire council area in the 2024/2025 financial year, and what was the total income received by the council from these PCNs during this period?*
