The TRO was made in 1995 and came into operation on 10 March 1995 which introduced a 30mph speed limit on Fornham Road, Great Barton under Sections 81, 82(2) and 83(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended).

(VARIOUS ROADS) (RESTRICTED ROADS AND REVOCATION) ORDER 1995**

Suffolk County Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 82(2) and 83(2) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following order:

1. The lengths of road specified in the schedule to this order shall be restricted roads for the purposes of Section 81 of the Act of 1984.
2. The provisions of The County Council of West Suffolk (40 mph Speed Limit) (No. 2) Order 1963 are hereby revoked.
3. The provisions of the Suffolk County Council (Parish of Great Barton) (B1106 Road) (40 mph Speed Limit) Order 1975 are hereby revoked.
4. This order may be cited as the Suffolk County Council (Parishes of Great Barton and Pakenham) (Various Roads) (Restricted Roads and Revocation Order) 1995 and shall come into operation on 10 March 1995.


On 21 February 1995 Suffolk County Council made the above order under Sections 82 and 83 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the order is to impose a 30 mph speed limit in Great Barton and Pakenham on the whole length of Anglesey Place, Aspen Close, Barton Hamlet, Bunbury Avenue, Chestnut Close, Chester Place, Conyers Way, Derby Place, Diomed Drive, Downing Drive, Eleanor Place, Elms Close, Green Way, Icepits Close, Maple Green, Mere Close, School Lane, School Road, Tewkesbury Place, West Wood and Woodland Place; and on part of Bury Road/The Street, East Barton Road, Fornham Road, Livermere Road, Mill Road, Pakenham Road, The Avenue and Thurston Road.

Full details may be obtained from the order.

A copy of the order, which comes into effect on 10 March 1995, and a map showing the roads affected, together with the Council's reasons for proposing to make the order, may be inspected at the offices of St Edmundsbury Borough Council, Angel Hill, Bury St Edmunds and at my office between 9.00 am and 5.00 pm Monday to Thursday and 9.00 am and 4.00 pm on Friday.
