

Environmental Information Regulations – Response - 26793

Please could you provide the following information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

I understand that prior to the commencement of major works at Tollgate Gyratory on September 29 last year, white lining was done around the junction. Please could you confirm:

- *Did this work take place?*

Yes

- *What roads did this take place on?*

Junction remarking was carried out at the Tollgate Lane junction with Mildenhall Road under works order 343296. These works addressed safety defects relating to missing priority road markings, in accordance with Suffolk County Council's Highways Maintenance Operational Plan (HMOP)

Thetford Road. Planned road marking refreshment works on Thetford Road extended from Fornham Farm access to Fornham Road junction on Tollgate Gyratory.

- *When did this work take place?*

Tollgate lane junction works were completed on 21 August 2025.

Thetford Road planned road marking refreshment took place 27 April 2025.

- *How long did this work last for?*

Tollgate Lane junction safety defect lining replacement was carried in one night shift.

Thetford Road planned road marking refreshment lasted for one night shift.

- *How much did it cost to redo the white lines?*

Tollgate Lane junction safety defect lining cost £2,057.05.

Thetford Road planned road marking refreshment cost £9,096.16. This includes both design and construction phases of work for the full extent of the scheme.

- *Was this included in the overall cost for the scheme? Or entirely separate cost?*

Tollgate lane junction works were separately funded through Suffolk Highways reactive maintenance budget.

Thetford Road planned road marking refreshment works were separately funded through capital maintenance budget and not included within the cost for the Tollgate Gyratory Junction Improvement scheme.
