

## **Environmental Information Regulations – Response - 26869**

*New Recently Required/Purchase Of Land By The Berkeley Group, Which is Adjacent To 'Entrance D' at Shepherds Grove Park, Stanton, Bury St Edmunds, Suffolk, IP31.*

*I am writing today to ask for your full assistance and cooperation in the requests that are shown below:*

*A ) What 'Plans' have been submitted regarding this Plot of land recently purchased by the Berkeley Group.*

*B ) What is this land being approved for, as you will have been asked for by the Berkeley Group.*

*C ) Copy of the Plans.*

*D ) If it is for New Homes/Park Homes to build on and erected, then how many will there be.*

*E ) Other than Homes/Park Homes, what other facilities will be put on this site.*

*F ) This land has a preservation order on it with regards to the Felling of any of the Trees on it.*

*G ) What plans are in place to preserve all the trees within this given area.*

*H ) If any as all trees are protected? then how many trees will be allowed to be cut down.*

*I ) How will you identify which trees can be cut down.*

We are writing to advise you that the information you requested is not held by Suffolk County Council (SCC). SCC Planning are only involved in planning applications for **new quarries or waste disposal sites** and as a statutory consultee on any planning applications that are proposed near such sites.

Planning applications are assessed and approved at District/Borough Council level, not County. SCC is a statutory consultee on a variety of specific issues that the local planning officers will request input on (drainage, transport, ecology etc), but do not approve plans.
