*This FOI is for the attention of council officers who oversee the private rented sector for the local authority.*

- 1. The total number of officers that work within housing enforcement for the local authority*
- 2. How many Environmental Health Officers work for the local authority whose main job is to enforce standards in the private rented sector? (Full Time)*
- 3. How many officers within the housing enforcement team are employed to resolve tenancy disputes, provide guidance to tenants, ensure that tenancy rights are upheld, and/or prevent homelessness*
- 4. If the local authority plans to recruit additional staff for housing enforcement in the next 12 months.*
