

Freedom of Information – Response – 26964

Under the Freedom of Information Act 2000, I am writing to request information regarding Suffolk County Council's Technology Enabled Care (TEC) service, commonly referred to as "Cassius".

Please provide the following information:

1. The current contractual end date.

May 2028

2. Confirmation of whether any extensions or variations have been exercised, including revised end dates.

The contract was initially awarded for a three-year term, with subsequent extensions applied at years four and six, each for a further two years.

3. Whether the Council intends to undertake a competitive procurement for the TEC service.

This is currently under discussion.

4. If a procurement is planned:

* *The anticipated procurement timetable,*

* *The proposed contract term,*

* *The estimated contract value (annual and total),*

* *The intended procurement route (e.g. open procedure, framework call-off, etc.).*

There are no additional details to share at this stage. Further discussions will take place in due course.

5. Any approved commissioning strategy, Cabinet decision, or internal governance reference relating to the future of the TEC service.

At this stage, there is no approved commissioning strategy, no Cabinet decision, and no internal governance approval relating to the future of the TEC service.

Suffolk County Council have not progressed any formal decision-making processes, and no proposals have been submitted for consideration.
