Thank you for your response. My 2nd question clearly had a typo so apologies for that - I have re-worded it below:

2. How much money was spent on the Parliamentary event (including travel, refreshments and other associated expenses) which took place in October 2025 (as shown below).



Event costs (including catering, room booking and hiring audio visual equipment):
£1,754.21

Travel costs: we estimate that travel costs amounted to £624.18. This relates to train travel for 8 people, as well as car parking charges and petrol mileage.

In addition, please could I request you share a copy of the letters sent from Suffolk County Council to the relevant Minister, or civil servants, in relation to the question of whether three unitary model should be part of the public consultation - as described in <https://www.bbc.co.uk/news/articles/c1jkzgzzn48o?app-referrer=deep-link>
We can confirm that Suffolk County Council holds this information. However, the information is readily accessible to you, as it is already in the public domain.
