

Environmental Information Regulations – Response - 27108

The Council have recently, within the last two weeks, contracted to 'repair' a dropped manhole cover just on the edge of Horringer village, approximately 50 meters to the east of Great Horringer Hall on the A143 to BSE. It was carried out during the late evening and necessitated the control of traffic using traffic lights.

I formally request the final cost for this specific 'repair'?

These works were undertaken to repair the damaged carriageway, which had deteriorated to a level requiring intervention in accordance with Suffolk County Council's Highways Maintenance Operational Plan (HMOP).

The highway gully was not damaged or sufficiently deteriorated to warrant intervention under the HMOP.

The final cost of the works has not yet been confirmed; however, the original order estimate was £488.64.
