- 1. The total number of reported fly-tipping incidents.*
- 2. The number of fly-tipping incidents investigated.*
- 3. The number of fixed penalty notices (FPNs) issued for fly-tipping.*
- 4. The number of prosecutions brought for fly-tipping offences.*
- 5. The total value (£) of fines issued for fly-tipping offences.*
- 6. The total cost (£) incurred by the council in clearing fly-tipping incidents (if recorded).*
- 7. The number of incidents involving:*
 - household waste*
 - commercial waste*
 - hazardous waste (if categorised)*
