

## **Environmental Information Regulations – Response – 27261**

*I am writing to make a formal request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000, relating to the car park at Nicolas Everitt Park, Oulton Broad, which I understand is operated by Suffolk County Council.*

*I understand that the car park entrance was previously fitted with metal one-way vehicle barriers. Please provide the following information in relation to the period during which those barriers were in place:*

*1. The total number of vehicles recorded as having been damaged by the metal one-way barriers at the car park entrance, including the dates of any such incidents where this information is held.*

*2. The total number of times the metal one-way barriers were repaired during the period of their installation, including the dates and nature of each repair where this information is held.*

*If you hold records relating to any insurance claims, complaints, or incident reports arising from vehicle damage caused by the barriers, I would also be grateful if you could confirm whether such records exist and whether they fall within the scope of this request.*

*We are writing to advise you that, following a search of our paper and electronic records, it has been established that the information you requested is not held by Suffolk County Council.*
