

Environmental Information Regulations – Response - 27381

Please confirm whether Suffolk County Council, SCC Highways, the Definitive Map team, or any contractor acting on SCC's behalf carried out any site visit, drive-through, photographic survey, video survey, highway asset survey, route inspection, mapping inspection, or road-status inspection of the farm track running from the A134 towards Cuckoo Tye Farm/Cuckoo Tye Farm House on 29 May 2026 at approximately 7.30am. This request includes, but is not limited to, any records relating to a vehicle with roof-mounted camera/survey equipment entering the track from the A134 and proceeding along the route, east to west towards Cuckoo Tye.

Please provide copies of any photographs, video stills, survey records, route plans, contractor instructions, internal emails, inspection notes, job sheets, GIS updates, asset records, or other documents created or relied upon in connection with that visit/survey. This request relates to the track adjacent to Cuckoo Tye Farm House, the recorded status and alignment of which is currently disputed.

The Definitive Map Team have confirmed that no one from their Team, visited this location on Friday 29 May 2026.

The Rights of Way and Access Operations Team have confirmed that no one from their Team visited this location on Friday 29 May 2026

The highways team did not visit this location on Friday 29/05/2026. There is a record on 11/05/2026 of a survey vehicle entering the lane at the A134 end incorrectly and turning around prior to surveying the eastern end highway maintainable at public expense.
