

## **Environmental Information Regulations – Response - 27382**

*Traffic-Calming Measures on Lansdowne Road, Lowestoft*

*I would therefore like to formally request:*

*1. A speed survey to assess vehicle speeds on Lansdowne Road.*

*2. Details of any previous speed assessments or traffic studies undertaken on this road.*

Existing data that the Traffic Survey Team has collected is available from [trafficsurvey@suffolkhighways.org](mailto:trafficsurvey@suffolkhighways.org) at a charge of £60 plus VAT per set of data.

*3. Information regarding any recorded collisions, incidents, or complaints relating to speeding in the area.*

SCC holds no collision data, involving injury, between the period of 01/03/21 to 28/02/26 (our latest available data) on Lansdowne Road, Lowestoft.

“The collision data referred to is provided and obtained from Suffolk Constabulary. To the best of our knowledge the data is accurate for the date range shown. The Collision Data team cannot accept responsibility for errors within the data.”

For the past 5 years plus 2026/27 YTD and there have been zero formal complaints raised about Lansdowne Road, Lowestoft.

*4. Consideration of traffic-calming measures, including speed humps, speed cushions, chicanes, or other suitable interventions.*
