

Environmental Information Regulations – Response - 27403

I would like to request information about the 7.5t HGV weight limit in Bungay.

A sign on the A143 indicates that entry into Bungay from Clays roundabout on the A143, is weight limited to 7.5t except for access.

This would indicate that vehicles travelling south on Broad Street are weight limited unless they are either delivering or picking up in Bungay.

1. The information I would like to know is where does this weight restriction end?

Bungay does not have an Environmental Weight Restriction Zone, it has a prohibition of entry by HGVs which is why there are no Zone End signs present.

2. Further, as there is no, “End of Restriction” sign at the end of Broad Street, where the road meets Market Place, does the 7.5t weight limit continue?

The exits from Market Place are Bridge Street, Trinity Street and Earsham street.

Bridge Street has its own sign showing it has a 7.5t weight restriction.

Earsham Street is part of the South/North transit route through Bungay so is not restricted.

However, the exit from Market Place into Trinity Street has no weight restriction signs, but as there is no “End of Restriction” sign at the end of Broad Street, I assume Trinity Street is a continuation of the 7.5t weight restriction that started at the beginning of Broad Street.

3. Is this correct? And if not, why not?
