

# **NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF PUBLIC PATH ORDER**

## **HIGHWAYS ACT 1980**

### **EAST SUFFOLK COUNCIL (CRATFIELD FOOTPATH NO 34 (PART)) PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2022**

On 15 December 2022 East Suffolk Council confirmed the above order made under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980.

The effect of the order as confirmed is to divert the entire width of that part of Cratfield Public Footpath No 34 commencing at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OSGR) TM29687457 and proceeding in a south westerly direction for approximately 95 metres from the boundary with Rose Farm to Laxfield Road (C516) at OSGR TM29607454 to a new line commencing from OSGR TM29687457 and proceeding in a west north westerly direction along the northern side of the field boundary with Rose Farm and Rose Farm Barn for approximately 211.5 metres to Laxfield Road (C516) at OSGR TM29497466 as described in the order and as shown on the order map.

A copy of the order as confirmed and the order map may be seen free of charge at Halesworth Library, Bridge Street, Halesworth, IP19 8AD between the hours of 09:00 and 17:00 Tuesday, Wednesday, Friday and 09:00 to 13:00 on Monday and 10:00 to 15:00 on Sunday. The order comes into force on 3 March 2023 but if a person aggrieved by the order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or of any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the order he or she may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within six weeks from 23 December 2022, make an application to the High Court.

This order is made by East Suffolk Council ("the authority") under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the authority that in the interests of the owners of the land crossed by the footpath described in paragraph 1 of the order it is expedient that the line of the footpath should be diverted.

Mr & Mrs Wilkins have agreed to defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of the order, and any expenses which are incurred in bringing the new site of the footpath into a fit condition for use by the public.

Suffolk County Council has been consulted as required by section 120(2) of the 1980 Act and has consented to the making of the order.

**BY THIS ORDER:**

1. The public right of way over the land situate at Cratfield and shown by a bold continuous line on the map contained in this order and on the Definitive Map and described in part 1 of the schedule to this order shall be stopped up with effect from the date on which Suffolk County Council certifies that the work to bring the new site of the footpath described in paragraph 2 of this order into a fit condition for use by the public has been carried out. Certification shall not take place prior to the creation of the new route described in paragraph 2 of this order.
2. There shall at the end of 70 days from the date of confirmation of this order be a public footpath over the land situate at Cratfield described in part 2 of the schedule and shown by a bold broken line on the map contained in this order.

## SCHEDULE

### Part 1

#### Description of Site of Existing Path

**Cratfield Public Footpath No 34(part)** – The entire width of that part of Cratfield Public Footpath No 34 commencing at Ordnance Survey grid reference TM29687457 at point A and proceeding in a south westerly direction for approximately 95 metres from the boundary with Rose Farm to Laxfield Road (C516) at Ordnance Survey grid reference TM29607454 at point B; this being the route shown between points A – B on the order map.

### Part 2

#### Description of Site of New Path

**Cratfield Public Footpath No 34(part)** – Commencing from Ordnance Survey grid reference TM29687457 at point A and proceeding in a west north westerly direction along the northern side of the field boundary with Rose Farm and Rose Farm Barn for approximately 211.5 metres to join Laxfield Road (C516) at Ordnance Survey grid reference TM29497466 at point C, with the southern edge of the footpath commencing two metres from the field boundary; this being the route shown between points A – C on the order map.

Width: 2 metres


