## NOTES

- Trees and hedge may be planted in slopes adjacent to swales without underdrains subject to appropriate soil properties, species selection and root protection agreed in writing with SCC - See Suffolk Design guide for tree in Highways.
- Area adjacent to carriageway to be constructed with 100 x 100 x 100mm granite setts on a Class 3 mortar bed 50mm thick with Class 3 12mm wide mortar joints to capture silt/debris from carriageway.
- Area to be extended to 1m to allow for street lighting.
- Topsoil 150mm thick with turf or planting as permitted design.
- Swale design to align with national & LLFA quidance: longitudinal slopes should be 0.5-6% (1:33) unless specific site/safety arrangements allow for alternative criteria. Check dams needed if gradient steeper than 0.5-6% (1:33).
- Minimum length of swale to be 5m.
- These swales can be used within impermeable soils.
- Top of gully grating to be 100mm above base of swale. For gully grating details see drawing no. DM-500-08.
