Had an initial visit with CYP, social worker and foster carer to explain what a PATH is and ensure that it was something the CYP wanted to engage with.

We then took note of her preferences i.e. snacks, music, location, attendees, and favourite colours.

We completed the PATH where she was able to see all the people in the room wanted to support her with her future plans.

- School had a much better understanding of the CYP and felt as though they had a better relationship with her after, resulting in discussions around how they should support her struggles at school.
- The CYP has a clear journey to September and key adults that have signed up to support her with next steps i.e travel training and joining extra-curricular activities.
