











Suffolk Police and Crime Panel meeting held on Friday 10 July 2015, in Bury St Edmunds.

Panel Report on:

Draft Variations to the Police and Crime Plan 2013-2017

- The Panel has a statutory duty to review the PCC's police and crime plan and any variations to it.
- The PCC's <u>varied plan</u> had been anticipated since the start of the year and the Panel had previously made <u>suggestions</u> to the PCC regarding its content.
- In the Panel's meeting on 10 July 2015 the discussion with the PCC about his varied Plan included reference to speed camera vans and roads policing, policing of people with mental health issues, and planning for and responding to major incidents and civil emergencies.
- The Panel **recommended** to the PCC, in light of the Panel's previous suggestions and also the ongoing increased terrorism threat, that he include within his Police and Crime Plan more specific information relating to responding to major incidents and civil emergencies in Suffolk.
- The Panel **resolved** to suggest to the Joint Emergency Planning Unit (JEPU) and its constituent Suffolk Local Authorities that there should be more elected councillor involvement in joint emergency planning.
