

**Motion:** Amendment to Motion 1 – Proposed by Councillor James Reeder and seconded by Councillor Beccy Hopfensperger.

'This council congratulates the National Health Service on its 70th birthday and extends its thanks to all those who have ever worked in the service. We are proud that this incredible institution was founded on the principle that every man, woman and child have access to the highest standard of free healthcare irrespective of their ability to pay.

We call on the Cabinet Member for Health to write to the Secretary of State urging him to increase funding for the NHS and Social Care in order to ensure the survival of the service for the next 70 years and beyond.'
