

Suffolk County Council meeting Thursday 18 March 2021, vote taken on Motion 1 as amended.

Motion 1 – Proposed by Councillor Matthew Hicks and seconded by Councillor Nick Gowrley.

Motion Text:

This Council applauds the major investment schemes announced for Suffolk by the Government two weeks ago as part of its levelling up agenda: namely the £50m Towns Fund awards for Ipswich and Lowestoft, and the establishment of FreeportEast, which is estimated to create 13,500 jobs and secure up to £650m investment in our region.

We are also proud of road schemes, delivered and under construction: Eastern Relief Road, Bury St Edmunds, Beccles Southern Relief Road, and the Eye Airfield which all unlock growth and generate new jobs for Suffolk residents. In parallel, the wide-ranging programme of work the Council is undertaking across Suffolk to promote and support sustainable transport is a further example of our wider ambitions for levelling up across Suffolk: leading on the East-West Rail link and campaigning for £20m track works at Haughley, which will improve connectivity between Ipswich and Norwich and Ipswich and Cambridge; the creation of a network of hundreds of community EV charging points and commercial rapid charging EV stations on strategic routes; trialling electric bus services and the identification of £20m of upgrades to our cycle network.

A key element of Suffolk's long term post-Covid recovery plan must be a programme of further highway improvements to support the county's businesses and boost our economy and we therefore welcome that upgrades to A12/14 Copdock Interchange and A11 Fiveways Roundabout are pipeline schemes within the current Regional Investment Strategy (RIS) programmes.

Therefore, this Council resolves to thank our MP's, district and borough partners and other key stakeholders in Suffolk for their support and assistance in securing Freeport status and the Towns Fund awards and to work with them and other stakeholders on securing this investment and:

- 1. Calls on the both the Department for Transport and Highways England to ensure that all the necessary preparations are carried out in respect of Copdock and Fiveways so that funding can be secured in the next RIS period.
- Write to the Secretary of State to reaffirm our support for the crucial projects to upgrade the A14, Britain's Premier Trading route, at Junction 37 at Exning; Junctions 43 and 44 at Bury St Edmunds and Junctions 56-58 around Ipswich.
