

Suffolk County Council meeting Wednesday 8 September 2021, vote taken on Motion 1.

Motion 1 – Proposed by Councillor Matthew Hicks and seconded by Councillor Richard Smith MVO.

Motion Text: 'As we emerge from the Covid-19 pandemic, Suffolk County Council recognises the importance of economic growth to help create the wealth needed to face the future with confidence and to repay some of the Government borrowing, which has been essential over the last eighteen months, to bolster both the economy and our health and care systems.

Suffolk County Council reaffirms its support for Suffolk's businesses by working to increase levels of skills and qualifications, leveraging investment to achieve the creation of more jobs and capitalising on the opportunities for green growth. This Council will encourage entrepreneurs to increase the scale of wealth-generation activities and to achieve this within the bounds of our Climate Emergency Plan. Increased wealth and growth and more jobs will benefit not just Suffolk's residents, but will help UK PLC achieve its economic and climate ambitions.

This necessity can be achieved in part by dynamic co-operation with our existing hubs of excellence which include telecoms research and development, import/export activities, renewable energy generation, marine research and the horse-racing industry, among many others across the county, all of which have their part to play to secure our economic future.'
