

Suffolk County Council meeting Thursday 19 May 2022, vote taken on Motion 3.

Motion 3 – Proposed by Councillor Sandy Martin and seconded by Councillor Elizabeth Johnson.

Motion Text:

- 1. This council recognises the fantastic work of carers across the county, and the important role they played during the pandemic working on the frontline.
- 2. This council also recognises that most care workers earn below the Real Living Wage as defined by the Living Wage Foundation, despite the vital role they perform.
- 3. This council is proud of the fact that it values its directly employed staff and pays them all above the Real Living Wage.

Suffolk County Council therefore resolves to ensure that all care workers in services it delivers or commissions:

- Are paid at least the Foundation Living Wage (currently £9.90 per hour)
- Are entitled to Covid-related sick pay (including whilst isolating)
- Are entitled to occupational sick pay
- Are provided with quality training and career pathways and will specify these conditions in all of its social care contracts.
