

Suffolk County Council meeting Thursday 9 February 2023, vote taken on Agenda Item 7 Revenue Budget 2023-2024 and Capital Programme 2023-2027, Green, Liberal Democrat and Independent (GLI) Group Budget Amendment.

Motion Amendment – Proposed by Councillor Andrew Stringer and seconded by Councillor Robert Lindsay.

Motion Text: Suffolk GLI Budget Amendment

GLI will propose an amendment to increase the council tax up **by 0.89%** above the Administration's current proposal. This will generate an additional £3.362m which is equivalent to an additional:

- a £12.78 annual rise/ 25 pence weekly rise for a Band D property, and
- a £9.94 annual rise / 19 pence weekly rise for a Band B property (the most common property type in Suffolk)

With the additional funding, the GLI Group propose:

- 1) To provide additional investment to employ a Carbon Budget Officer to lead SCC to a clearer path to Net Zero by 2030. **(£50k)**.
- 2) To provide additional funding for Suffolk Library Services to help absorb budgetary/inflationary costs and provide a necessary service that generates £6.07 in Suffolk for every £1 invested (£300k).
- 3) To provide additional funding for Suffolk Community Transport to help them invest in and electrify their minibus and car fleet. (£1m).
- 4) To fund the first phase of a "sign and line only" approach to reduce speeds in residential areas via a pilot, as well as an engagement and communications strategy to support transition and implementation. (£1m).
- 5) To not increase the vacancy factor in ACS, as proposed by the Conservatives, to recognise the risk that staff recruitment will accelerate enabling ACS to fully recruit to their staffing establishment for social workers in 2023-24. (£1m).
- 6) However, redirect £50k of the above funding to employ a Good Will Officer within the ACS Directorate responsible for working with external stakeholders and carers to ensure a wider, more direct pool of local benefits for carers in the eventual lead to the adopting of a 'Suffolk Carers Cultural Pass', aimed to increase retention levels of carers.
- 7) To provide funding to facilitate an initiative to create a Suffolk Carers Cultural Pass, to help retain/recruit Suffolk carers. (£12k).
