We are pleased to inform you that the Autumn 2021 upgrades for SIMS. net and FMS have been released and can now be applied via SOLUS3.

Please be aware that if your SOLUS3 is set to upgrade automatically, SIMS, FMS and Discover will have upgraded at 18:00 on the 18/11/21. If SIMS is not on version 7.202 and FMS are not on version 6.202, SOLUS3 has not upgraded SIMS and/or FMS.

CENSUS DATES FOR 2022

For Head Teachers and administration staff responsible for submitting the termly census returns to the DfE

Every school in England has a statutory duty to complete the school census each term.

Please put the following dates in your diaries to ensure your census returns are submitted on time.

SIMS

Spring census – Thursday 20th January

Summer census – Thursday 19th May

Autumn census – Thursday 6th October (provisional date – not confirmed)

Workforce census - Thursday 3rd November (provisional date - not confirmed)

The census helpline, 01473 260666, will be open the week of each census, from Monday to Thursday 08.30am – 5pm and Friday 08.30am - 4.30pm. All enquiries outside of census week can be logged in the normal way, via the IT Service Desk on 01473 265555.





SIMS

We understand that LA schools have received a communication with regards to the SIMS Service and clarity for the future.

Suffolk County Council were made aware last week that ESS were intending to communicate directly with schools and expressed our concern at this.

We have been aware that they wish to change the arrangements under which they contract and have been attempting to fully understand the reasons for this and the implications and benefits to schools in Suffolk.

At the moment, Suffolk County Council have a contract in place with ESS until 31st March 2025. We then contract with LA maintained schools on an annual basis. We are aiming to confirm our position with ESS this week, which is likely to include the need for us to conduct a stakeholder engagement exercise with all schools impacted. We also need to complete our due diligence on their proposals. We hope to be in a position to confirm all of this in the next week or so.
