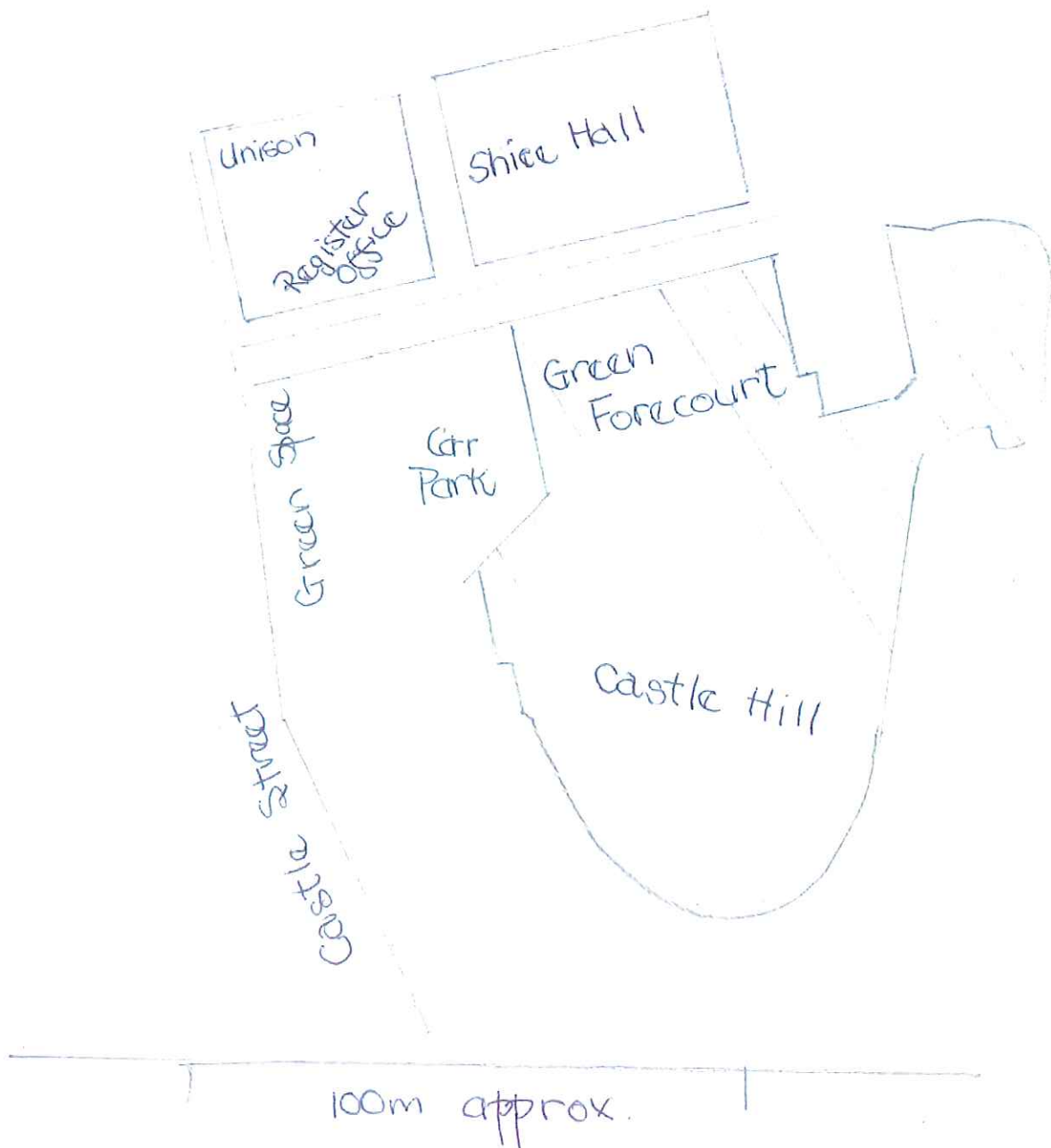

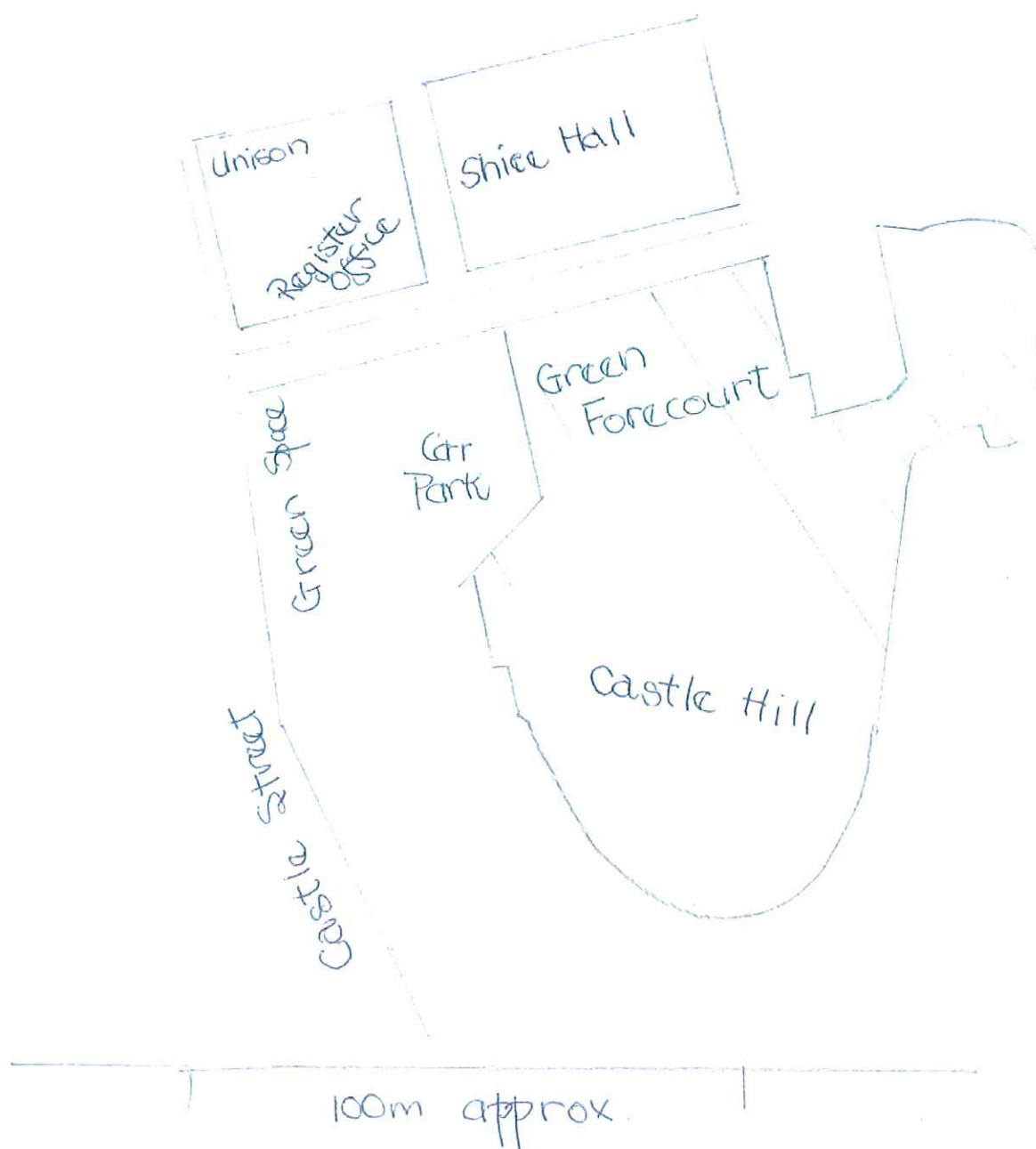

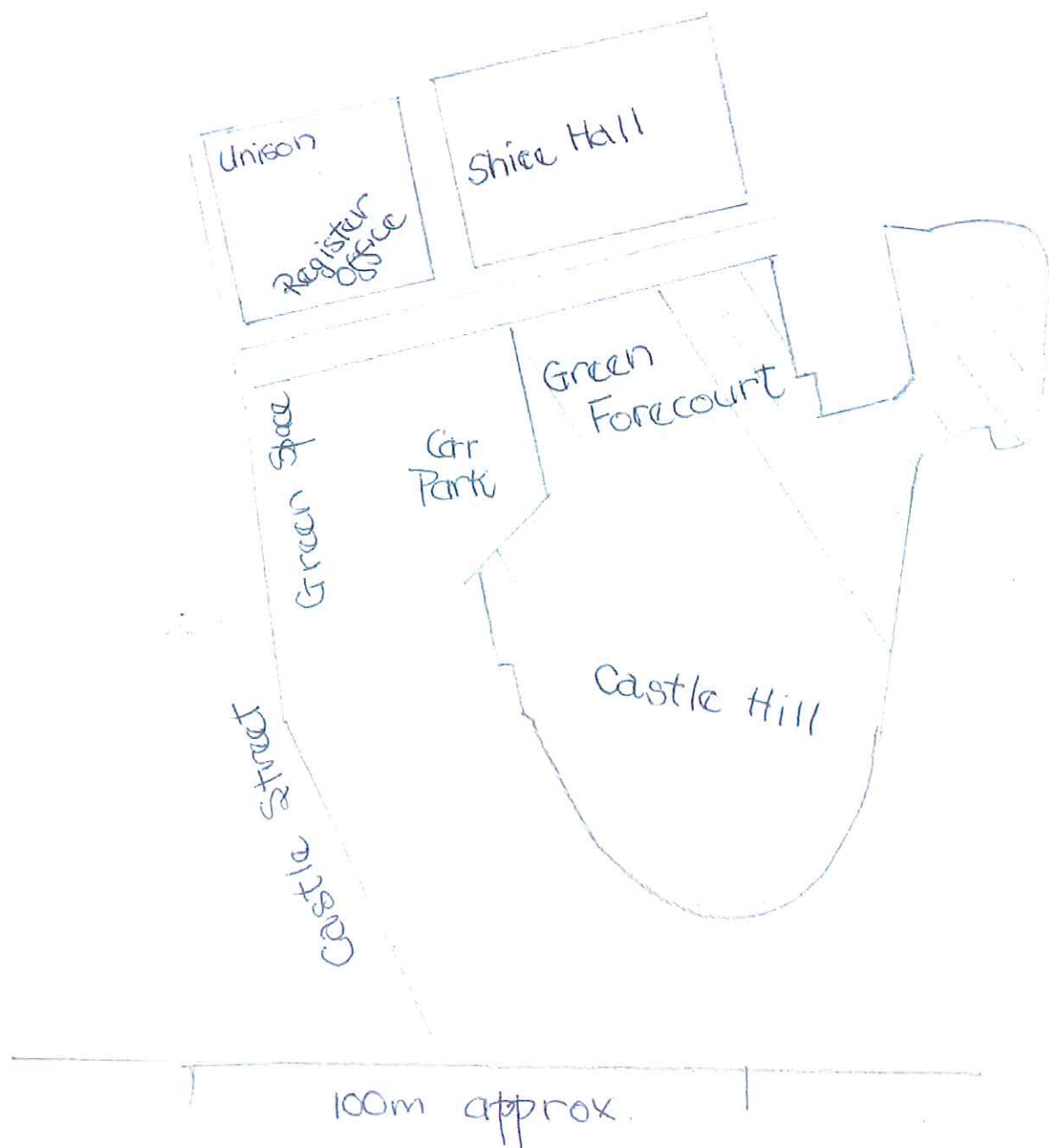

<p>If you have any additional information, please add it below.</p> <p>I was born in Cambridge, and brought up in a Magdalene College house on Chesterton Road. I cannot remember a time when I have not gone up the mound from time to time. Even when we lived in Over, we used to park on Saturdays on the Shire Hall site, and would often go up for the view. All our other houses have been in easy walking distance of it.</p> <p>I have just (7 February) been up to watch the sunset. While I was there, between four and nine other people, including accompanied children, were up at the same time with the same aim. Several dog-walkers were criss-crossing the green in front of the Shire Hall. I talked to a woman with a child who, like many local people, I suspect, was still unaware of the potential threat to access to the mound.</p>

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

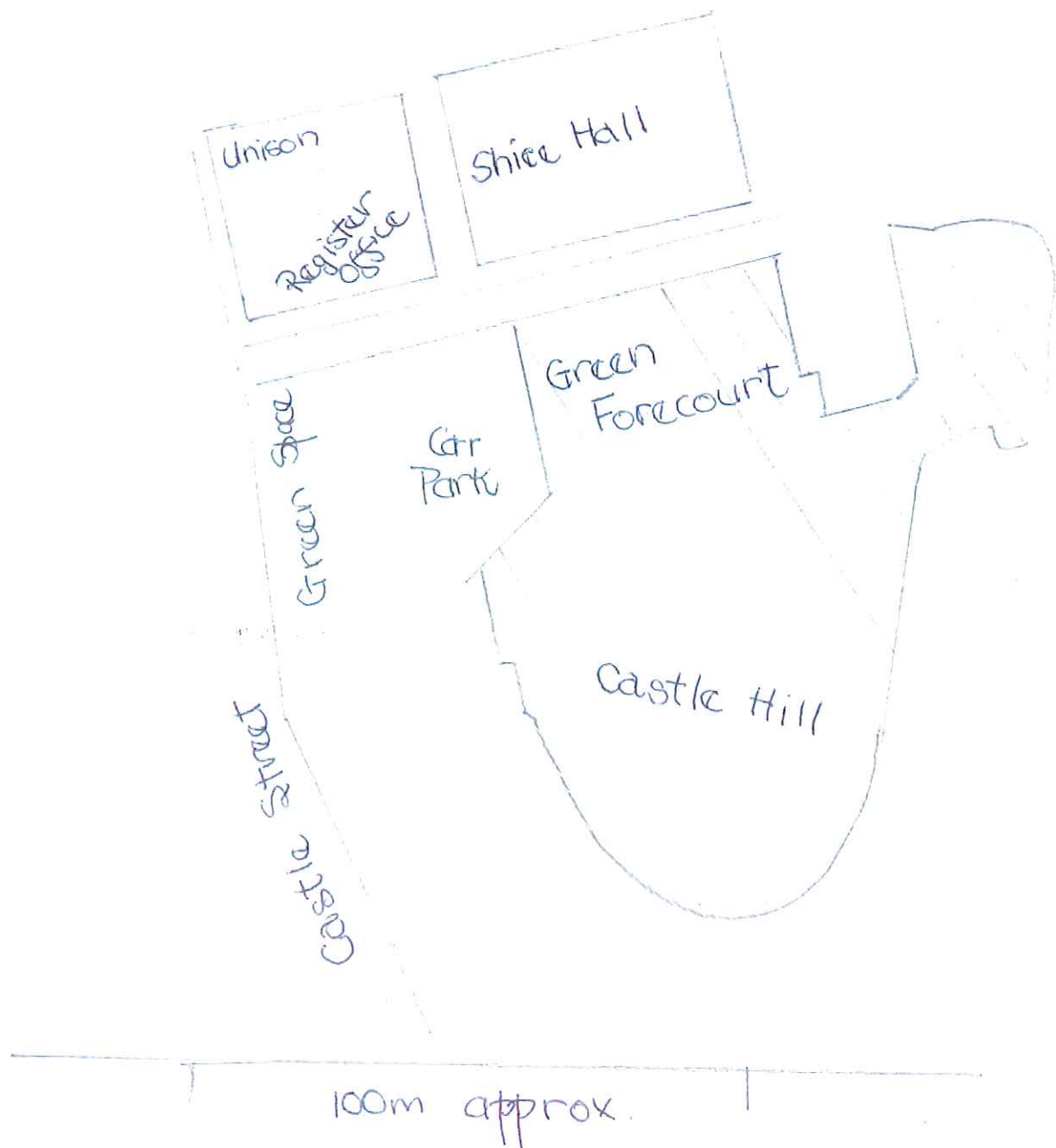
