8 December 2020	Cabinet	Yes	Suffolk County Council (SCC) Housing Approach – Joint Venture	Following approval of the SCC Housing Approach in January 2020 Cabinet is asked to consider a business case in relation to the potential procurement of a private sector joint venture partner in order to support this initiative. The SCC Housing Approach stated that a variety of models for the delivery of housing are appropriate and one option to consider is delivery via a joint venture partner. External advisors were appointed in summer 2020 to review SCC sites with the potential for residential development in order to determine the risks and benefits of delivery via a joint venture partner. The external advisors have worked with Finance, Legal, Procurement, CLT, Concertus, Corporate Property and People teams to understand SCC aspirations, risk appetite and suitability for a joint venture structure. The outcomes of the work have been reported to the Housing Board. This Cabinet report will set out the conclusions of the work performed regarding the joint venture business case and the resultant recommendation.
