NOTICE OF PUBLIC PATH ORDER

HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

MID SUFFOLK DISTRICT COUNCIL (WORTHAM FOOTPATHS NOS 21(PART) AND 22(PART)) PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2022

On 15 July 2022 Mid Suffolk District Council confirmed the above order made under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980.

The effect of the order as confirmed is to divert the following public footpaths at Wortham Long Green as described in the order and as shown on the order map:

Wortham Footpath No 21(part) - the entire width of that part of Wortham Footpath (FP) No 21 commencing at Ordnance Survey grid reference (OSGR) TM08757713 and proceeding in a north westerly direction for approximately 65 metres to a junction with Wortham Footpath No 22 at OSGR TM08697716 to a new line commencing at OSGR TM08757713 and proceeding in a west south westerly direction for approximately 59 metres through a belt of trees to OSGR TM08697711 then in a west north westerly direction for approximately 4 metres to the edge of the belt of trees at OSGR TM08697712 then in a westerly direction for approximately 7 metres to a junction with the new route of Wortham Footpath No 22 at OSGR TM08687712.

Wortham Footpath No 22(part) - the entire width of that part of Wortham Footpath No 22 commencing at OSGR TM08687717 and proceeding in a southerly and then south south easterly direction for approximately 11 metres to a junction with Wortham Footpath No 21 at OSGR TM08697716 then in a generally south south westerly direction for approximately 54 metres to OSGR TM08677711 to a new line commencing at OSGR TM08687717 and proceeding for approximately 7 metres in an east south easterly direction and across a footbridge to OSGR TM08697717 then continuing in an east south easterly direction for approximately 7 metres to OSGR TM08707717 then in a south south westerly direction for approximately 53 metres adjacent to the hedge forming the boundary of a property known as Meadow End Cottage with the western edge of the footpath commencing 1.2 metres from the centre line of the hedge to a junction with the new route of Wortham Footpath No 21 at OSGR TM08687712 then in a south westerly direction for approximately 10 metres with the north western edge of the footpath commencing 0.5 metres from the boundary fence of Meadow End Cottage to join the existing route at OSGR TM08677711.

The order comes into force on 24 September 2022 but if a person aggrieved by the order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or of any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the order he or she may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within six weeks from 22 July 2022, make an application to the High Court.

This order is made by Mid Suffolk District Council ("the authority") under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the authority that in the interests of the owners of the land crossed by the footpaths described in paragraph 1 of this order it is expedient that the lines of the paths should be diverted.

Ward Duffin Developments Ltd has agreed to defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of the order, and any expenses which are incurred in bringing the new sites of the paths into a fit condition for use by the public.

Suffolk County Council has been consulted as required by section 120(2) of the 1980 Act and Suffolk County Council has consented to the making of the order.

BY THIS ORDER:

- The public rights of way over the land situate at Wortham and shown by bold continuous lines on the map contained in this order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this order shall be stopped up with effect from the date on which Suffolk County Council certifies that the work to bring the public footpaths described in Part 2 of the Schedule to this order into a fit condition for use by the public has been carried out. Certification shall not take place prior to the creation of the new routes as described in Paragraph 2 of this order.
- There shall at the end of 70 days from the date of confirmation of this order be public footpaths over the land situate at Wortham described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by bold broken lines on the map contained in this order.

SCHEDULE PART 1 DESCRIPTION OF SITES OF EXISTING PATHS

Wortham Footpath No 21(part) – The entire width of that part of Wortham Footpath No 21 commencing at Ordnance Survey grid reference TM08757713 at point A and proceeding in a north westerly direction for approximately 65 metres to a junction with Wortham Footpath No 22 at Ordnance Survey grid reference TM08697716 at point B; this being the route shown between points A – B on the order map.

Wortham Footpath No 22(part) - The entire width of that part of Wortham Footpath No 22 commencing at Ordnance Survey grid reference TM08687717 at point C and proceeding in a southerly and then south south easterly direction for approximately 11 metres to a junction with Wortham Footpath No 21 at Ordnance Survey grid reference TM08697716 at point B then in a generally south south westerly direction for approximately 54 metres to Ordnance Survey grid reference TM08677711 at point D; this being the route shown between points C - B - D on the order map.

PART 2 DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF NEW PATHS

Wortham Footpath No 21(part) – Commencing at Ordnance Survey grid reference TM08757713 at point A and proceeding in a west south westerly direction for approximately 59 metres through a belt of trees to Ordnance Survey grid reference TM08697711 at point E then in a west north westerly direction for approximately 4 metres to the edge of the belt of trees at Ordnance Survey grid reference TM08697712 at point F then in a westerly direction for approximately 7 metres to a junction with the new route of Wortham Footpath No 22 at Ordnance Survey grid reference TM08687712 at point G; this being the route shown between points A - E - F - G on the order map.

Width: 1.5 metres

Wortham Footpath No 22(part) — Commencing at Ordnance Survey grid reference TM08687717 at point C and proceeding for approximately 7 metres in an east south easterly direction and across a footbridge to Ordnance Survey grid reference TM08697717 at point J then continuing in an east south easterly direction for approximately 7 metres to Ordnance Survey grid reference TM08707717 at point H then in a south south westerly direction for approximately 53 metres adjacent to the hedge forming the boundary of a property known as Meadow End Cottage with the western edge of the footpath commencing 1.2 metres from the centre line of the hedge to a junction with the new route of Wortham Footpath No 21 at Ordnance Survey grid reference TM08687712 at point G then in a south westerly direction for approximately 10 metres with the north western edge of the footpath commencing 0.5 metres from the boundary fence of Meadow End Cottage to join the existing route at Ordnance Survey grid reference TM08677711 at point D; this being the route shown between

points C - J - H - G - D on the order map.
