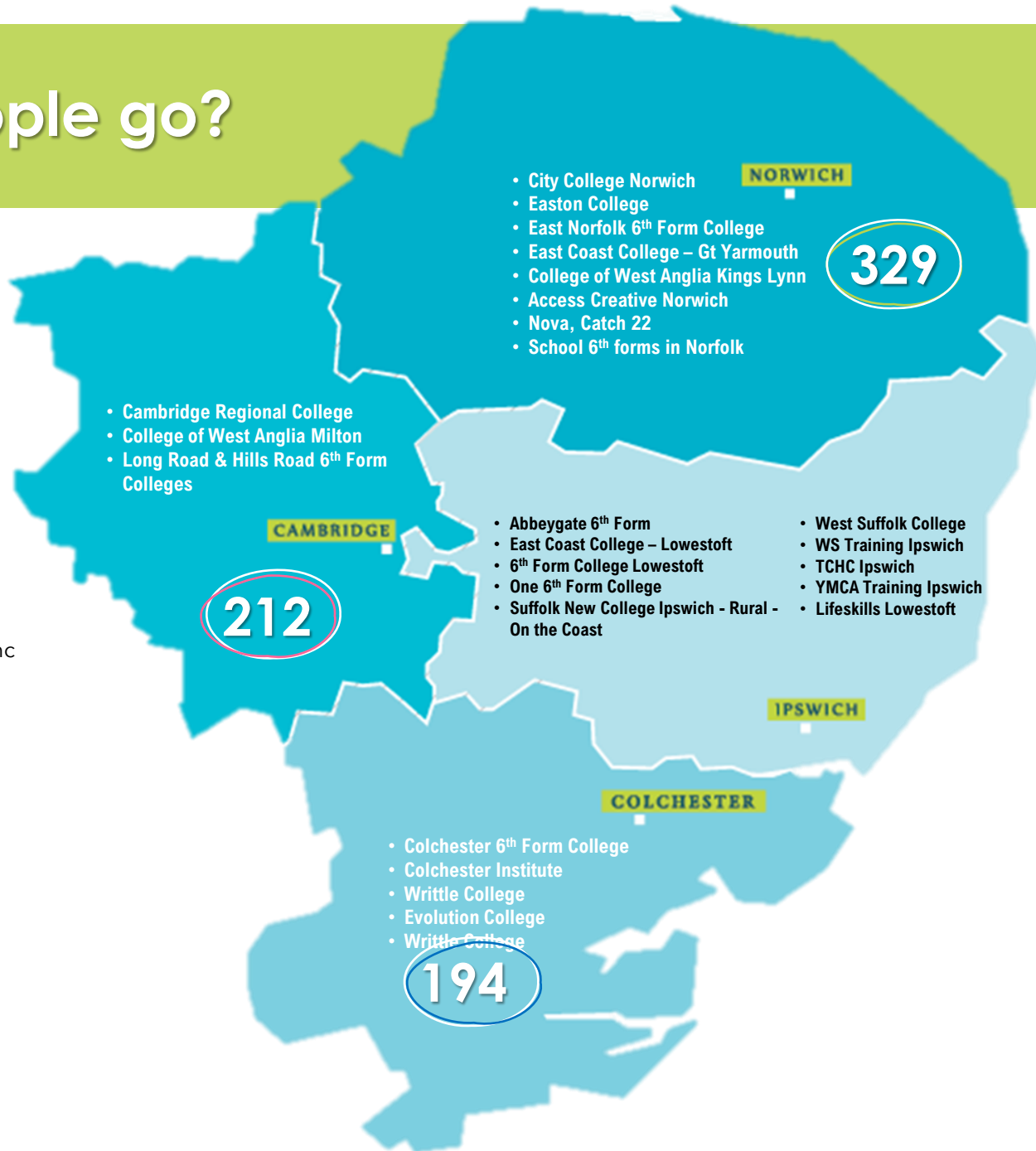

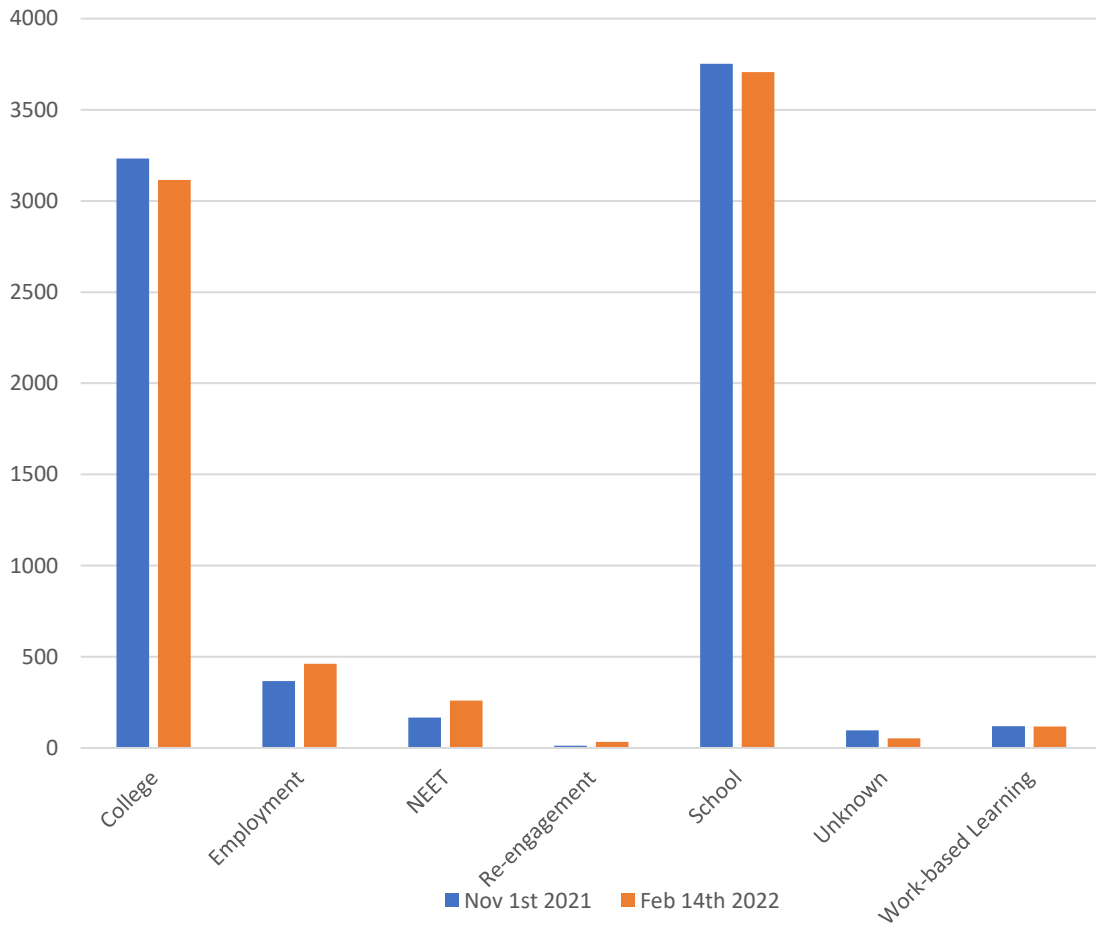

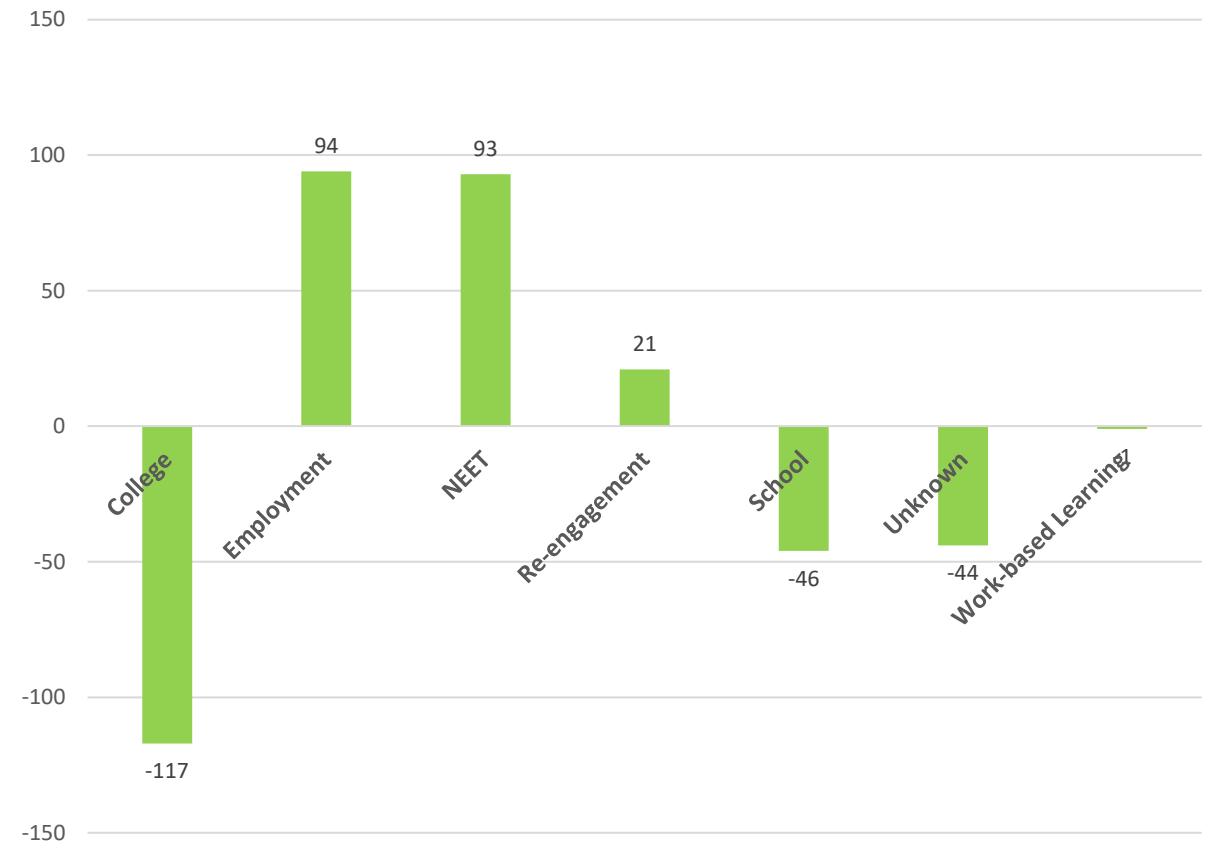

2 purposes of the cohort check:

- who is and isn't on your school roll,
- up-to-date contact info *

NB.

- Those operating a year behind and ahead
- Names + gender – when they are different
- Young people with a PRU but still on roll

- 2nd cohort lists for checking early April + Sept Offer info on same spreadsheet – deadline 4th May (at least 2 weeks to respond around hols)
- Cohort fixed end of May 2022

Sept Offers + Activity Survey

- **SEPT OFFER** = student has applied and been offered an unconditional place
- Sept offer College updates, + other post 16 organisations inc 6th forms **March – Aug**
- * **LIST from schools with a 6th form***
- School update **Sept Offers –April- May 4th** (with cohort check) but ongoing up to the end of term
- ***Termly meetings** with EHT YPW link re who is likely to be NEET* - ongoing + transition work over summer
- **Activity Survey** = what students are actually doing in Year 12 – snapshot on 1st November
