Examples includes things like:



Warm Homes Suffolk is a service to help vulnerable and low income households make their homes cheaper to heat and can provide:



Grants for loft and wall insulation

(Insulation helps keep heat in your home)



 Grants for renewable heating systems

(For example, heat pumps)



Grant for solar panels



 A free home energy efficiency survey to discuss ways to make your home warmer and healthier



• Free draught-proofing



 Loan of portable heaters in case your heating breaks down
