Notice of an application for the registration of land as a Town or Village Green

To every reputed owner, lessee, tenant or occupier of any part of the land described below, and to all others whom it may concern.

Suffolk County Council is dealing with an application made by Dr Jocelynn Annette Scutt, Elizabeth Claire Richards & Katie Thornburrow under section 15(1) of the Commons Act and in accordance with the Commons (Registration of Town or Village Greens) (Interim Arrangements) (England) Regulations 2007). The application seeks the inclusion in the register of town and village greens of the land described in the Schedule below which is claimed to have qualified for registration as a town or village green on 10 January 2019 by virtue of the fact that the application site has been used “as of right” for informal recreational purposes for a period of at least 20 (twenty) years preceeding the registration of the landowner’s deposit on 10 January 2019.

If the registration authority is satisfied that the land described below qualifies for registration as a town or village green, it will so register the land.

Any person wishing to object to the registration of the land as a town or village green should send a statement of the facts on which the objection is based to Corinne McGrath at the address below on or before **12 January 2022** Any representations that are to be taken into account by the Authority in reaching a decision on the application cannot be treated as confidential and will be copied to the applicant for comment and may be disclosed to other interested parties.
