

SUFFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL (PARISH OF OULTON) (HALL LANE, WOOD LANE AND HOLLY HILL) (30 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2022

Suffolk County Council proposes to make the above-named order for Oulton under Section 84(1) (a) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended. The effect of this would be to introduce a 30 mph speed limit on:

- Holly Hill from its junction with the Wood Lane and Hall Lane for 213 metres in a southwesterly direction;
- Wood Lane from its junction with Hall Lane and Holly Hill to its junction with Queens Highway; and,
- Hall Lane from a point 15 metres west of its junction with the B1074 to its junction with Holly Hill and Wood Lane.
