1. Introduction

- 1.1 An infrastructure funding statement (IFS) is a statutory document that must be published each year by a "contribution receiving authority". A contribution receiving authority is any authority that issues a community infrastructure levy (CIL) liability notice or receives money or works in-kind from a section 106 agreement.
- 1.2 The requirement to publish an IFS originated from the changes made to the CIL Regulations, The Community Infrastructure Levy (Amendment) (England) (No. 2) Regulations 2019 (https://www.legislation.gov.uk/uksi/2019/1103/regulation/9/made) in September 2019. Paragraph 121A, of Part 10A 'Reporting and monitoring on CIL and planning obligations' requires that:
 - '(1) no later than 31st December in each calendar year a contribution receiving authority must publish a document ("the annual infrastructure funding statement") which comprises the following—
 - (a) a statement of the infrastructure projects or types of infrastructure which the charging authority intends will be, or may be, wholly or partly funded by CIL (other than CIL to which regulation 59E or 59F applies) ("the infrastructure list");
 - (b) a report about CIL, in relation to the previous financial year ("the reported year"), which includes the matters specified in paragraph 1 of Schedule 2 ("CIL report");
 - (c) a report about planning obligations in relation to the reported year, which includes the matters specified in paragraph 3 of Schedule 2 and may include the matters specified in paragraph 4 of that Schedule ("section 106 report").
 - (2) The first annual infrastructure funding statement must be published by 31st December 2020.
 - (3) A contribution receiving authority must publish each annual infrastructure funding statement on its website.
 - (4) Nothing in paragraph (1) requires a contribution receiving authority to include in its annual infrastructure funding statement any information in relation to CIL which it collects on behalf of another charging authority.
 - (5) In this regulation, "contribution receiving authority" means -
 - (a) any charging authority which issues a liability notice during the reported year;
 - (b) any local planning authority (within the meaning in section 1 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 as that section has effect subject to sections 2 to 9 of that Act) to which a sum is required to be paid under a planning obligation, entered into during the reported year, or which will receive a non-monetary contribution under the obligation.'

- 1.3 This document is the second IFS published by Suffolk County Council (SCC). The first Suffolk County Council IFS was published in December 2020 and covered the period 1st April 2019 to 31st March 2020, as well as all secured, received, and unspent money from previous years.
- 1.4 The information provided within this document relates to all the new activity in the reporting year for the period 1st April 2020 to 31st March 2021. Following this current update of the IFS, the County Council may publish an interim update if the data on section 278 highway agreements is available prior to the next annual review, which would be due by 31st December 2022.
- 1.5 The information that is published in an IFS differs from authority to authority. As the County Council is not a CIL Charging Authority, its duty is to report on one of the three components set out in the regulations relating to section 106 contributions. However, this document also includes CIL funding that has been awarded to the County Council from either Babergh District Council, East Suffolk Council or Mid Suffolk District Council.
- 1.6 This IFS provides a summary of all financial and non-financial developer contributions relating to section 106 Legal Agreements (s106), and the Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL) received by Suffolk County Council (the County Council) for the reporting year.
- 1.7 Throughout this document, there are references to the following definitions:
 - **Secured** the total amount of money to be provided under any planning obligations which were entered into during the reported year. These contributions may not have been received, and if the planning applications are not implemented, they will never be received.
 - Received and allocated the total amount of money under any planning obligations which was received during the reported year. Contributions are assigned a local financial code that is unique to each contribution.
 - **Spent/Delivered** the total amount of money (received under any planning obligations) that was spent by the authority (including transferring it to another person to spend). The contribution has been 'drawn down' by the service.
 - **Total amount of money** the total amount of money (received under any planning obligations) that was allocated but not spent during the reported year for funding infrastructure.
 - **Reporting Year** unless stated otherwise, this refers to the period 1st April 2020 31st March 2021.

2. Developer Contributions

Section 106 Agreements and Planning Obligations

- 2.1 Planning obligations can be secured through either a section 106 agreement or a unilateral undertaking, depending on the nature of the development. A unilateral undertaking is a simplified version of a planning agreement and is entered into by the landowner and any other party with a legal interest in the development site. A section 106 agreement, on the other hand, is a more complex legal agreement that can be attached to a planning permission to mitigate the impact of development.
- 2.2 Planning obligations can only be sought where they meet the three legal tests under Regulation 122(2) of the CIL Regulations and set out within paragraph 57 of the National Planning Policy Framework (NPPF):
 - necessary to make the development acceptable in planning terms;
 - directly related to the development; and
 - fairly and reasonably related in scale and kind to the development.
- 2.3 The Council's expectations for s106 planning obligations are set out in the Developers Guide to Infrastructure Contributions in Suffolk.
- 2.4 S106 obligations can be infrastructure contributions provided on-site, for example, through the delivery of land for a new school or off-site in the form of financial payments.

Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL)

- 2.5 In contrast to s106 obligations, the Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL) is a fixed rate payment that District or Borough Councils can charge on new development in their area to off-set the impacts of additional homes and businesses on infrastructure such as health, schools, libraries and waste facilities to enable sustainable growth. CIL monies can be used to fund the provision, improvement, replacement, operation or maintenance of infrastructure to support the development of the area.
- 2.6 CIL rates are set out via a published Charging Schedule, and the following councils in Suffolk have implemented a CIL:
 - Babergh District Council;
 - East Suffolk Council (covering the former Suffolk Coastal District and Waveney District areas); and
 - Mid Suffolk District Council.

Relationship between local planning authorities and Suffolk County Council for s106 and CIL

2.7 Where a local planning authority (LPA) has adopted a CIL Charging Schedule, the way in which infrastructure providers seek developer contributions changes. Projects which may have previously been funded by

- planning obligations in s106 agreements might now be funded via the CIL mechanism.
- 2.8 Except where charging authorities expect specific projects or types of infrastructure to be wholly or partly funded by a CIL, the County Council will continue to use s106 to seek planning obligations on behalf of its service areas in order to mitigate the impacts of development on local communities.

Section 278 Highway Agreements

- 2.9 Additional legal agreements that can fund infrastructure are section 278 highway agreements (s278). These are legally binding agreements made under the Highways Act 1980 between the Local Highway Authority and developers; s278 agreements are required to secure alterations or improvements to the public highway. The County Council is currently compiling s278 data for publication within future versions of the IFS.
- 2.10 As referred to in the introduction, the CIL Regulations (as amended 2019) sets out the requirements in respect of the IFS. Schedule 2¹ of the regulations sets out the 'Matters to be included in the annual infrastructure funding statement'. Under Schedule 2, paragraph 4, the regulations state:
 - '4. The matters which may be included in the section 106 report for each reported year are
 - (a) summary details of any funding or provision of infrastructure which is to be provided through a highway agreement under section 278 of the Highways Act 1980, which was entered into during the reported year,
 - (b) summary details of any funding or provision of infrastructure under a highway agreement which was provided during the reported year.'
- 2.11 Although the above regulation is a recommendation to include s278 data, it is the intention of the County Council to provide this information as soon as it is available.

Forecasting

2.12 National guidance suggests that councils should consider reporting on estimated future income where possible. The County Council will look at incorporating forecasting of developer contributions in the IFS for future reporting years.

Borrowings

2.13 The County Council, from time to time, borrows money to forward fund infrastructure projects. In those cases, the County Council will look to retrospectively recover the infrastructure investment made through s106 and/or CIL bids.

- 2.14 In April 2019 (with a further update in November 2019), the Government, through the Department for Education (DfE), published a document to guide education and planning authorities with seeking developer contributions for new education facilities to support housing growth: 'Securing developer contributions for education.'2
- 2.15 Paragraphs 6 and 7 of this document refer to forward funding:
 - '6. While basic need funding can be used for new school places that are required due to housing development, we would expect this to be the minimum amount necessary to maintain development viability, having taken into account all infrastructure requirements. Where you have a reasonable expectation of developer funding being received for certain school places, and you have declared this in your SCAP return (or plan to do so), then basic need funding should not be considered available for those school places other than as forward funding to be reimbursed by developer contributions later.
 - 7. There are other options besides basic need grants for forward-funding school places, including the use of local authority borrowing powers where necessary. Where new schools or school expansion is necessary to mitigate the impacts of development, and those new facilities are to be forward funded (for example, by local authorities borrowing money to fund school development prior to receiving section 106 monies or by using capital reserves), it may be possible to secure developer contributions to recoup the monies spent, including interest, fees and expenses as well as the principal sum spent. Where this model is envisaged, we recommend that you engage with the local planning authority before forward funding occurs to ensure that the local planning authority supports this approach. The CIL Regulations prohibit borrowing against future CIL receipts, so this method of forwardfunding only applies to planning obligations. Local authorities can bid for funding under government grant programmes such as the Housing Infrastructure Fund (HIF) as they become available, while developers delivering schools directly as an 'in kind' contribution may be eligible for loan funding from DfE or Homes England, allowing a new school to be delivered at an earlier stage in the development than would have been possible otherwise.'
- 2.16 Schedule 2 ('Matters to be included in the annual infrastructure funding statement') of the CIL Regulations (as amended 2019), paragraph 1(g) refers to:
 - '(g) in relation to CIL expenditure for the reported year, summary details of— (ii) the amount of CIL spent on repaying money borrowed, including any interest, with details of the items of infrastructure which that money was used to provide (wholly or in part);.'

- And paragraph 3(h)(ii) refers to: '3. The matters to be included in the section 106 report for each reported year are -
- (h) in relation to money (received under planning obligations) which was spent by the authority during the reported year (including transferring it to another person to spend), summary details of -
- (ii) the amount of money (received under planning obligations) spent on repaying money borrowed, including any interest, with details of the items of infrastructure which that money was used to provide (wholly or in part);.'
- 2.17 A list of projects where borrowings have been used is provided in Table 6. Capital projects which use borrowings are also listed within the County Council's Capital Programme³.

3. s106 Contributions

3.1 In accordance with the regulations⁴, the responses to the following matters form the County Council's fulfilment of an infrastructure funding statement:

The total amount of money secured to be provided under any planning obligations which were entered into during the reporting year:

- 3.2 The County Council entered into **71** planning agreements during the reporting year. This includes 62 section 106 Agreements and 9 unilateral undertakings⁵ (UU). It also includes two s106 agreements that are under the same agreement reference and same development site (matter reference 56938 Thurston (Rougham), land south-west of Beyton Road (Fishwick Corner, Thurston Road)). The amount of contributions secured from these agreements totals £13,498,502.
- 3.3 In certain circumstances, planning agreements are modified or varied; this legal proceeding to change a planning agreement is called a deed of variation⁶ (DOV). Of the 71 planning agreements secured in this reporting year, 17 have since had deeds of variations (13 on s106 agreements and 4 on unilateral undertakings).
- 3.4 The first IFS, which was reported in autumn 2020, had a total amount of contributions secured for that reporting year of £46,626,990. The main difference between this current reporting year and the last is that there were large planning permissions that secured considerable sums of s106. For example, this was the case for the development of 1,250 dwellings in Bury St Edmunds (land south of Rougham Hill, 'Abbots Vale', DC/15/2483); and the

Ipswich Garden Suburb development of 1,915 dwellings (IP/14/00638 and IP/16/00608). Together, both these developments in Ipswich and West Suffolk have contributed to over 2/3 of the amount of contributions secured during the period 2019-20.

- 3.5 In terms of the number of dwellings, the last reporting year saw a total of 6,820 dwellings for which a planning agreement had been signed, compared with 2,535 dwellings in this reporting year (excluding cases of DOVs).
- 3.6 The table below provides the list of the 4 unilateral undertakings signed during this reporting year, which are mentioned above. These have no financial implications.

- 3.8 Some of these contributions may have already been paid to the County Council, but the majority will be calculated and paid at the later agreed trigger points (for example, on the commencement of the development build or, for larger sites, these payments may be phased) over the coming years.
- 3.9 The County Council has a good track record of securing developer contributions to help mitigate the impacts of new development. However, developer contributions can only be sought where they meet the 3 legal tests, so there may be instances in which the improvement of existing infrastructure or the delivery of new infrastructure will require additional funding from other sources.
- 3.10 Please see 'Appendix 1' and 'Appendix 2'- all-new s106 legal agreements entered into during the reporting year 2020/21 and a full list of the contributions secured.

The total amount of money under any planning obligations which was received during the reporting year:

- 3.11 £10,120,820 was received during the reporting year and not spent. These contributions either fund part or all project costs and are allocated in accordance with the clauses of the legal agreements, as explained in paragraph 3.13 below.
- 3.12 A large proportion of the funding received will fund new schools and school expansions to accommodate the population growth. Funding also included contributions for transport, waste, and library projects.

The total amount of money under any planning obligations which was received before the reporting year which has not been allocated by the authority:

3.13 As soon as a contribution is paid to the County Council, it is allocated to the relevant service and project as described in the s106 agreement. Therefore, for the period up until and including 31st March 2021, there is no received money that has not been allocated, i.e., £0.

Summary details of any non-monetary contributions to be provided under planning obligations which were entered into during the reporting year, including details of the number of school places for pupils which will be provided, and the category of school at which they will be provided:

3.14 The table below provides a summary of the non-monetary contributions that were secured through s106 agreements in the reporting year 2020/21. A 2.2ha school site is large enough to ultimately deliver a 420-places primary school and 60-places early years setting.

3.18 The County Council has spent £8,724,239 from s106 during the reporting year. See Appendix 3 for a breakdown.

- (iii) the amount of money (received under planning obligations) spent in respect of monitoring (including reporting under regulation 121A) in relation to the delivery of planning obligations;
- 3.22 The County Council charges a minimum of £412 for each trigger point in a planning obligation towards administration costs. The fee is based upon the occurrence of triggers for compliance of a planning obligation rather than each obligation individually. The monitoring fee is to be paid on completion of the s106 legal deed, as the County Council has to start administration activities from that point onwards.
- 3.23 Since the CIL regulations in 2019 allowed a monitoring fee, the County Council started to secure monitoring fees on planning obligations from September 2019.
- 3.24 £28,942 was received during the reporting year, and all of it was spent during the same reporting year.

The total amount of money (received under any planning obligations) during any year which was retained at the end of the reporting year, and where any of the retained money has been allocated for the purposes of long-term maintenance ("commuted sums"), also identify separately the total amount of commuted sums held.

- 3.25 The total amount which has been received and allocated (in any year) (up to 31st March 2021) but will be spent in upcoming years is £28,613,410. S106 funding is closely monitored and robustly managed via a vigorous internal sign-off mechanism to ensure that it is used for the purpose identified within the original agreement.
- 3.26 The reason the above figure is significant is that many contributions have a period of 10 years for the County Council to spend the money. Larger infrastructure projects such as school expansions or new schools are often linked to other developments, and these developments will not secure all s106 contributions at the same time as the first. The infrastructure projects themselves may only be delivered when a substantial quantum of growth has arisen.

 - Bramford Primary School school expansion
 - Stowupland High School school expansion

Abbots Green Primary Academy, Bury St Edmunds, West Suffolk



4.2 The project involved the expansion of the existing school through the build of additional class-bases, a hall extension, internal remodelling and a standalone pre-school facility. The project has increased the capacity of the school by 105 pupil places (from 420 to 525 places). The project has increased the

school from 2 FE to 2.5 FE from Reception to Year 6 and 30 additional Early Years places.

The project was completed and handed over in July 2020.

4.4 The project consisted of the expansion of the existing school by 105 pupil places (from 210 to 315 places). This expansion has increased the school from 1FE to 1.5FE from Reception pupils to Year 6. The project has delivered a new stand-alone four classroom block, along with an office, storage space and WCs. The project was completed and handed over in August 2020.

- 4.5 The project consisted of the expansion of the existing high school through the reconfiguration of internal space and construction of a new Sixth Form block to create additional capacity.
- 4.6 This project has increased capacity for secondary school pupils (ages 11 to 16) by 125 places (from 925 to 1050 places) and by 15 additional Sixth Form places (from 185 to 200 places).
- 4.7 The new 6th Form block is purpose-built and independent from the main high school building. The project was completed and handed over to the school at the end of January 2021.

5. Highway Agreements

5.2 The County Council will look at the possibility of including information for highway agreements within future versions of the IFS.

6. Community Infrastructure Levy

- 6.1 Although the County Council is not a CIL charging authority, CIL funding is received for some infrastructure projects following successful bids to the local planning authorities (LPAs), who are CIL Charging Authorities.
- 6.2 It is important for the County Council to receive CIL funding to deliver the infrastructure necessary to mitigate development in the districts. The consequence of the County Council not receiving CIL funding would mean projects not being delivered, or where other funding (historic s106 contributions) is primarily delivering the project, the County Council would have to borrow money to pay for the funding gap. For every £10m borrowed, the cost of borrowing is currently estimated at £510k per annum for 30 years.
- 6.3 The County Council provides details below of the successful awarding of CIL funding. This includes collection and subsequent spend.

The items of infrastructure on which CIL (including land payments) has been spent and the amount of CIL spent on each item.

- 6.4 For this reporting year, there are no infrastructure projects for which the County Council was awarded CIL funding. This is consistent with the IFSs produced by the three CIL Charging Authorities within Suffolk (Babergh District Council, East Suffolk Council and Mid Suffolk District Council).
- 6.5 Although many projects which benefited from CIL funding have come to fruition during the reporting year, as detailed in section 4, and the County Council has recently been awarded CIL funding for other projects, these fall outside of the reporting year. The table below, however, lists those recently awarded CIL projects for information.
