

Stowupland Sixth Form Expansion: Public Exhibition

Suffolk County Council is consulting on a proposal to increase the existing accommodation at Stowupland High School. The new accommodation will provide a two-storey stand-alone block to provide purpose built teaching spaces, study and social areas for use by sixth form pupils. The new accommodation will make space available within the main building to increase the capacity of the school.

Further external works are also proposed to increase car and cycle parking provision at the school as well as improvements to coach parking.
