

New Lakenheath Primary School: Public Exhibition

Suffolk County Council is consulting on a proposal to construct a new school building for Lakenheath Primary School. The new accommodation will provide a two-storey stand-alone block to provide purpose-built teaching spaces, leisure, and social areas for young people in Lakenheath. The new accommodation will make space available to facilitate the increase in population within Lakenheath associated to new housing developments within the area.

External works are also proposed to provide hard and formal play, habitat area, a welcoming site frontage, new car park and drop-off.

Plans of the proposed development may be viewed at www.suffolk.gov.uk/consultations and will also be available for you to view at the school during normal school hours until **Monday 19th June**.

This is a non-statutory pre-application planning consultation aimed at gathering the views of parents, staff and local residents prior to the submission of the planning application. It does not affect the right to comment on the proposals during the statutory planning consultation process.
