Before this role, I worked as a teacher in a secondary school.

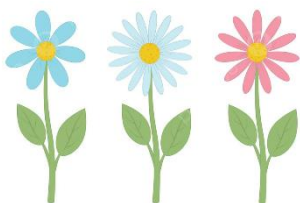
What people appreciate about me
